Pedestrian and Railroad Bridge Painting Project Begins Construction

ALACHUA COUNTY, Fla. – Construction on a project to complete maintenance and rehabilitation work on two bridges in Alachua County began this month. This project includes the State Road 25/U.S. 441 pedestrian bridge and the State Road 200/U.S. 301 bridge over State Road 24/CSX railroad.

No lane closures will be permitted on the State Road 25/U.S. 441 pedestrian bridge from 6:30 a.m. to 10:30 p.m. Drivers can expect intermittent lane closures and flagging operations on these bridges until the rehabilitation project is complete.

Seacoast, Inc. was selected to complete this \$742,390 project, which includes re-coating of existing structural steel and anchor bolt replacement on both bridges. Completion is estimated in mid-2024, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
