Portion of State Road 13 to Temporarily Close for JEA Work Tonight

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will temporarily detour lanes of State Road 13 from Race Track Road to Cunningham Terrace to faciliate JEA water main work starting tonight, Friday, March 12 at 10 p.m. Drivers will be detoured around the closure via Fruit Cove Terrace.

Northbound State Road 13 will be closed Friday, March 12 from 10 p.m. to 8 a.m., and southbound State Road 13 will be closed Saturday, March 13 from 10 p.m. to 8 a.m., weather and schedule permitting.



This work is part of FDOT's resurfacing project on State Road 13 from Mill Creek to the Duval County line that started in February 2021.
