FDOT to Host Public Hearing for Proposed State Road 25 Median Modification

Micanopy, Fla. – A public hearing regarding a proposed median modification on State Road 25 along U.S. 441 will be held Wednesday, January 29 at the town hall building, 706 NE Cholokka Boulevard, Micanopy, Florida 32667. It will begin with an open house from 4 to 5:30 p.m., followed by a public comment period at 5:30 p.m. Attendees will have the opportunity to view displays and discuss the proposed changes with project staff and consultants.

FDOT is proposing to close a full median opening along U.S. 441 and upgrade the traffic signals at the intersection of U.S. 441 and County Road 234W. These improvements are part of a larger project that will resurface the pavement of U.S. 441 and make operational and safety improvements between Alachua County Line and State Road 331/Williston Road. The proposed modifications will reduce conflicts and enhance safety at the intersection.

Project documents will be available for review at the public hearing and are currently posted on www.nflroads.com. Attendees who complete a speaker's card will be given the opportunity to make an oral statement that will become part of the public hearing record. Persons wishing to submit written statements or other exhibits in place of or in addition to oral statements may do so at the hearing or by sending them to Victor Marrero, 1109 S. Marion Avenue, Lake City, Florida 32025. All exhibits or statements postmarked on or before February 8, 2020 will become part of the public hearing record.

Public participation is solicited without regard to race, color, national origin, age, sex, religion, disability or family status.
