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S.R. 20 Drainage Improvement Project Quickly Moving into Phase Two

Palatka – As part of the S.R. 20 drainage improvements from Osceola Street to Reid Street, S.R. 20 (9th Street) from Laurel Street to Carr Street (map 1) will be closed for pipe installation work from Monday, November 12 through early 2019, barring unforeseen circumstances such as bad weather.

Motorists traveling north on S.R. 20 at Carr Street will detour north on 12th Street, east on Carr Street, north on 10th Street and east on Laurel Street to travel back to S.R. 20 northbound.

Motorists traveling south on S.R. 20 will detour east on Laurel Street and south on Crill Avenue back to S.R. 20.

The construction project includes removing the top layer of asphalt and replacing it, installing new drainage pipes under the roadway, constructing new storm drain, base work, improving curb and gutter, reconstructing sidewalk and driveway, utility work, clearing the right of way and other incidental construction.

Temporary full roadway and sidewalk closures will occur throughout each phase of the project; however, vehicle and pedestrian detours will be provided. Commercial truck traffic should utilize the existing truck route for S.R. 20.

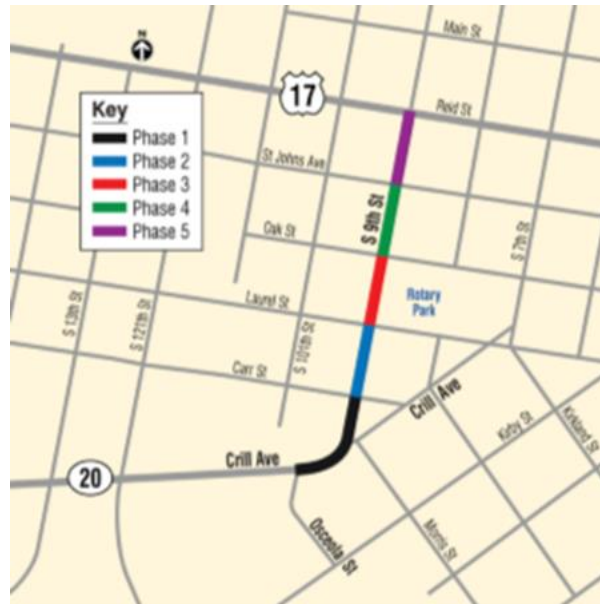
Throughout each phase of this project, a portion of S.R. 20 from Osceola Street to Reid Street (U.S. 17) will be closed to all vehicle and pedestrian traffic. Construction for each phase (map 2) is estimated to take between four and six weeks, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

Halifax Paving, Inc. is expected to complete the \$2 million improvement project by summer 2019, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
