REVISED: U.S. 90 Resurfacing Project through Baldwin Begins in July

BALDWIN, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation will begin work Tuesday, July 5 on the U.S. 90/State Road 10 resurfacing project from the Duval/Nassau County Line to Delmonte Street.

This project will include milling and resurfacing the existing pavement, shoulder widening, drainage improvements, school crossing updating, replacing a traffic signal, ADA compliant sidewalk improvements and other pedestrian signal and lighting.

Lane closures are not permitted on this project weekdays 6:30 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. Lane closures are also restricted on school days within 600 feet of a school zone in the mornings one hour before and 30 minutes after school begins and in the afternoons one hour before and 30 minutes after school ends.

Preferred Materials, Inc. was selected to complete the \$4.07 million project by early 2023, weather and schedule permitting.
