Ramp Closure at San Pablo Road/Butler Boulevard Rescheduled for Tonight

Jacksonville, Fla. – Due to inclement weather, the ramp closure at Butler Boulevard and San Pablo Road originally scheduled for June 24 has been rescheduled for tonight, weather permitting. The ramp from San Pablo Road to westbound Butler Boulevard will close overnight starting at 8 p.m. Thursday, June 25 and reopen by 6 a.m. Friday, June 26. The closure will allow for installation of a 24-inch water main across the ramp.

Detour: To access westbound Butler Boulevard, drivers will be detoured to eastbound Butler Boulevard, where they will continue to the South Beach Parkway exit and turn left onto South Beach Parkway to access the ramp onto westbound Butler Boulevard.



FDOT hired Watson Civil Construction to complete this \$12 million project, which includes construction of a diverging diamond interchange at San Pablo Road and Butler Boulevard, in spring of 2022, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
