Ramp Closures on I-10 Between First Coast Expressway and Nassau County Line Scheduled Aug. 13 to Aug. 18

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – Drivers can expect ramp closures on I-10 from Nassau County Line to First Coast Expressway (State Road 23) from Tuesday, Aug. 13 to Sunday, Aug. 18 for milling and resurfacing. Closures will be in place nightly from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.

The U.S. 301 ramp to I-10 westbound will be closed Tuesday, Aug. 13. Northbound U.S. 301 drivers will detour via U.S. 90 west to State Road 121 and head south on State Road 121 to access I-10. Southbound U.S. 301 drivers will continue south to State Road 228 and take State Road 228 to access I-10.

The eastbound I-10 ramp to U.S. 301 will be closed Friday, Aug. 16 and Sunday, Aug. 18. Drivers will take either State Road 121 or State Road 228 north to U.S. 90 east to access U.S. 301.
