Ramp Closures on I-10, Chaffee Road and I-295 Planned Overnight Friday

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – As part of a resurfacing project on I-10 between Chaffee Road and I-295, drivers can expect nighttime ramp closures for milling and resurfacing from 7 p.m. Friday, Aug. 2 to 5 a.m. Saturday, Aug. 3, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

- **Chaffee Road ramp to eastbound I-10 closed:** Drivers on Chaffee Road will continue north to U.S. 90 east, then take Hammond Boulevard south to access I-10.
- **I-295 southbound ramp to eastbound I-10 closed:** Drivers on I-295 will continue south to Normandy Boulevard (State Road 228) and re-enter I-295 northbound to access eastbound I-10.

Anderson Columbia was awarded the \$26 million contract to complete resurfacing on I-10 between Chaffee Road and I-295. This project is expected to be completed by mid-2025, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
