Ramp Closures on I-10, Chaffee Road and I-295 Scheduled Aug. 4 to Aug. 11

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – As part of a resurfacing project on I-10 between Chaffee Road and I-295, drivers can expect nighttime ramp closures Sunday, Aug. 4 through Sunday, Aug. 11 for milling and resurfacing. Closures are planned from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m., weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

Sunday, Aug. 4 and Monday, Aug. 5, the southbound I-295 ramp to eastbound I-10 will be closed for resurfacing. Drivers on I-295 will continue southbound, exit Normandy Boulevard (State Road 228) and re-enter I-295 northbound to access eastbound I-10.

Monday, Aug. 5 and Tuesday, Aug. 6, the northbound I-295 ramp to westbound I-10 will be closed for resurfacing. Drivers on I-295 will continue north and exit Commonwealth Avenue and re-enter I-295 southbound to access I-10 westbound.

Tuesday, Aug. 6 to Thursday, Aug. 8, the southbound I-295 ramp to westbound I-10 will be closed for resurfacing. Drivers on I-295 will take eastbound I-10 to Lane Avenue and use Lane Avenue to access westbound I-10.

Tuesday, Aug. 6 and Wednesday, Aug. 7, the I-10 eastbound ramp to Hammond Boulevard will be closed for resurfacing. Drivers will continue east on I-10 to the Lane Avenue exit and take I-10 westbound to access Hammond Boulevard.

Wednesday, Aug. 7 and Thursday, Aug. 8, the southbound Hammond Boulevard ramp to I-10 eastbound will be closed for resurfacing. Drivers on Hammond Boulevard will continue southbound to Normandy Boulevard east and then north on Lane Avenue to access I-10.

Anderson Columbia was awarded the \$26 million contract to complete resurfacing on I-10 between Chaffee Road and I-295. This project is expected to be completed by mid-2025, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
