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S.R. 243 detour and traffic pacing planned for Pecan Park Roadway project

Jacksonville – In conjunction with the Florida Department of Transportation’s roadway-widening project on Pecan Park Road from I-95 to east of Lexington Park Boulevard, the Jacksonville Electric Authority (JEA) will be implementing a traffic pacing operation Sunday, March 4 from 6 a.m. to 8 a.m. on I-95 south and north at Pecan Park Road to safely complete electrical work.

Traffic pacing operations (rolling road block) will be coordinated by law enforcement officers and JEA personnel.

In addition, S.R. 243 (JIA N. Access Road) between Owens Road and Pecan Park Road will be temporarily closed for roadway reconstruction at Bainbridge Drive for 100 days, weather and schedule permitting to complete new drainage crossing installation and paving work starting Wednesday, March 7 at 6 a.m.

Pecan Park road traffic will be detoured west on Pecan Park Road to travel south on Pecan Park Road to east on Dixie Clipper Road. Airport Road traffic will detour west to Pecan Park Road to north on Pecan Park Road and east on Pecan Park Road to S.R. 243.

Petticoat-Schmitt Civil Contractors Inc. began the \$17.4 million widening project July 10, 2017 and are expected to complete the reconstruction work in late 2018, schedule permitting.
