

San Pablo Road Ramp to Eastbound Butler Boulevard to Close Overnight

Jacksonville, Fla. – As part of the Florida Department of Transportation’s interchange improvement project at Butler Boulevard (State Road 202) and San Pablo Road, the ramp from San Pablo Road to eastbound Butler Boulevard will close overnight starting at 8 p.m. Wednesday, May 6. The ramp is expected to reopen by 6 a.m. Thursday, May 7, weather and schedule permitting. The closure will allow for safe installation of a water main across the ramp.

Detour: Drivers wishing to access eastbound Butler Boulevard will take Butler Boulevard west to the Hodges Boulevard exit, where they will be able to access eastbound Butler Boulevard.



FDOT hired Watson Civil Construction to complete this \$12 million project, which includes construction of a diverging diamond interchange at San Pablo Road and Butler Boulevard, in spring of 2022, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
