Sandridge Road to Close Overnight Feb. 19 for First Coast Expressway Work

CLAY COUNTY, Fla. – As part of First Coast Expressway construction, Sandridge Road will close at Rolling View Boulevard overnight Wednesday, Feb. 19, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting. The roadway will close at 11 p.m. and reopen by 5 a.m. the following morning. During the closure, traffic will detour via Henley Road and Russell Road. Emergency vehicle access will remain available throughout the closure.
