Snell Street Closed at Lem Turner Road for Roadway Repairs

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – Access from Snell Street to Lem Turner road will be unavailable from Thursday, March 21 through Saturday, April 6 to allow crews to repair a depression in the roadway. The repairs are located within the project limits of FDOT's resurfacing project on Lem Turner Road (State Road 115) from Soutel Road to Thomas Creek.

As a detour, drivers will travel south on Lucas Street and east on Armstrong Street to access Lem Turner Road.

Duval Asphalt is estimated to complete the \$16.4 million project by summer 2024, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
