State Road 20 Landscaping Project to Begin Next Week

HAWTHORNE, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation's State Road 20 from U.S. 301 to the Putnam County line landscaping project is expected to begin next week, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

The project consists of plantings and irrigation along SR 20 from east of U.S. 301 to the Putnam County line.

Traffic will be maintained in accordance with FDOT design standards throughout the project.

FDOT selected Oasis Landscaping Services, Inc. to complete construction on this \$1.19 million project in fall 2023, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting, followed by a two-year establishment period.
