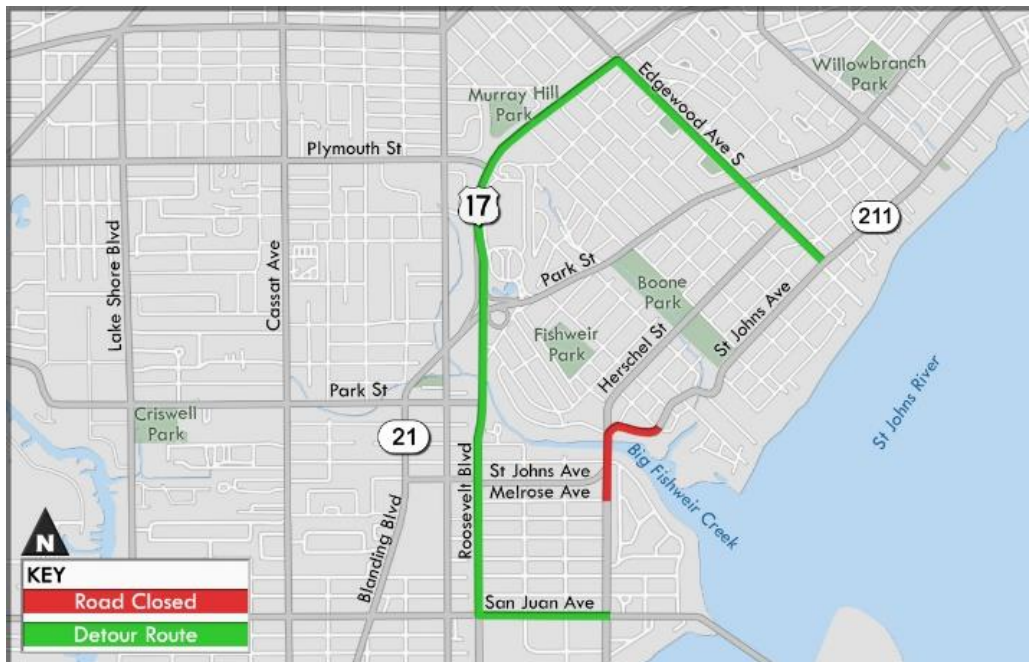

State Road 211 Detour Planned Next Week for Asphalt Paving

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation is scheduled to detour State Road 211 (St. Johns Avenue) from Melrose Avenue to Canterbury Street beginning Wednesday July 20 at 7 p.m. through Monday July 25 at 5 a.m., weather and schedule permitting.

As shown in the map below, traffic will be detoured to San Juan Avenue, U.S. 17 and Edgewood Avenue South to allow crews to perform asphalt paving operations as part of the State Road 211 (St. Johns Avenue) from Herschel Street to Canterbury Street Intersection Improvements Project.
