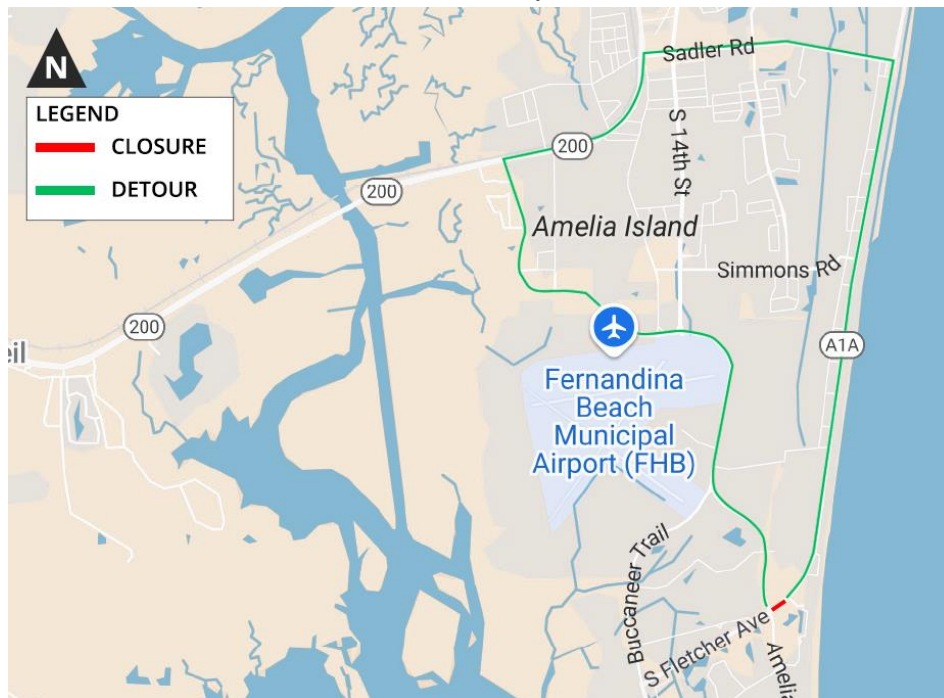
### State Road A1A/South Fletcher Avenue to see Two-Week, Continuous Detour for Golf Cart Bridge Repair

**FERNANDINA BEACH, Fla.** – State Road A1A/South Fletcher Avenue in Fernandina Beach will see a two-week continuous detour between Peters Point Road and Amelia Island Parkway for repairs to the Amelia Island Golf Cart Bridge.

While the bridge is not a state-owned facility, all structures over state roadways require inspections and a robust maintenance schedule to protect the safety of all roadway users.

Both directions of SR A1A/South Fletcher Avenue just north of Amelia Island Parkway will close Tuesday, Oct. 15 and are expected to reopen Thursday, Oct. 31, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

Throughout the closures, all roadway users will be detoured to Amelia Island Parkway, SR 200 and Sadler Road, as indicated in the map below.
