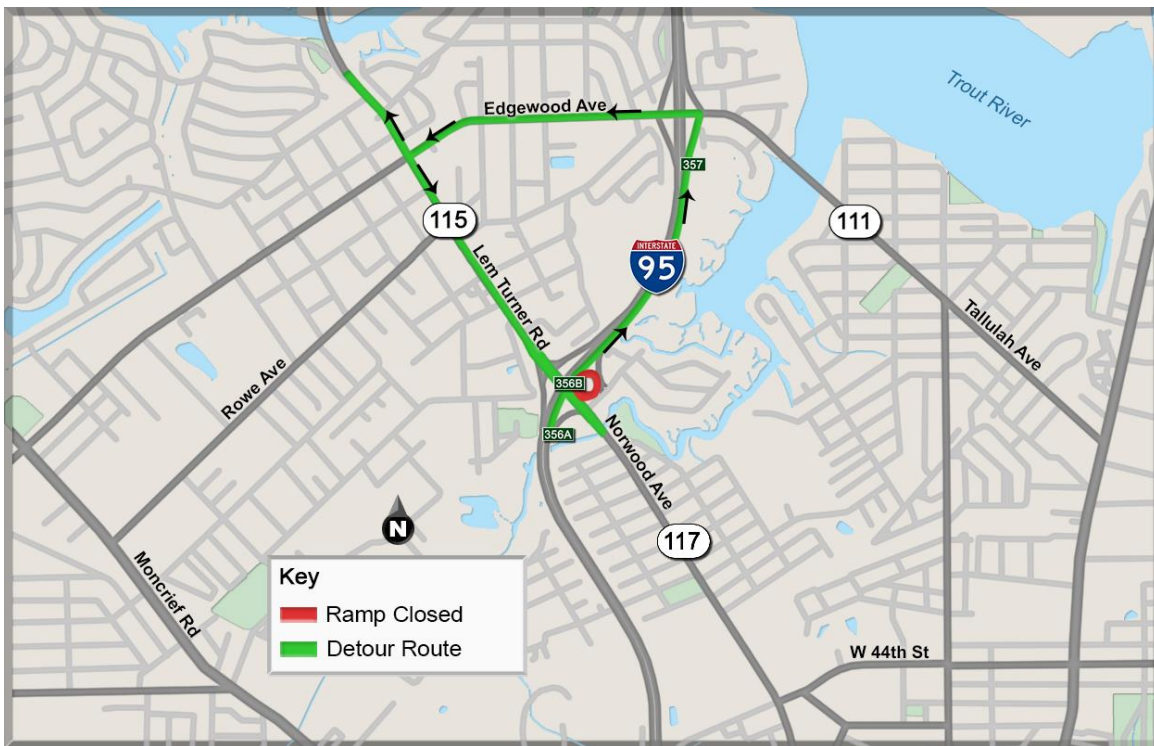

### TRAVEL ADVISORY: I-95 Northbound Lem Turner Road Off-ramp Closed Overnight Monday

**JACKSONVILLE, Fla.** – The I-95 northbound off-ramp to Lem Turner Road (Exit 356B) will be closed Tuesday, December 15, from 6:30 p.m. to 6:30 a.m. for paving operations, weather permitting. Traffic will detour north to Edgewood Avenue (Exit 357) and continue west on Edgewood Avenue towards Lem Turner Road.
