Traffic shift planned Wednesday on Pecan Park Road at I-95

Jacksonville – As part of the widening improvement project on Pecan Park Road from I-95 to east of Lexington Park Boulevard, traffic will be shifting on to new pavement on the south side of the roadway from east of Lexington Park Boulevard to approximately half a mile west of I-95 Thursday, October 17 for crews to complete work on the north side, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

Local access to the north side of the roadway will remain available for residences during construction. S.R. 243 (JIA N. Access Road) will also be open to traffic.

Petticoat-Schmitt Civil Contractors Inc. began the \$17.4 million widening project July 10, 2017 and are expected to complete the reconstruction work in early 2019, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
