Travel Advisory: State Road 200 Lane Closure Schedule

Yulee, Fla. – This advisory is to inform community leaders and interested parties about upcoming, scheduled lane closures, traffic shifts and other construction activity on State Road 200/A1A.

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) has permitted multiple lane closures as part of the State Road 200/A1A (S.R. 200) improvement projects. Below are several planned lane closures, weather permitting, planned for June 1 through June 7. Certain activities may require unexpected lane closures for the safety of both drivers and construction workers.

Notable: Intermittent daytime closures are expected to take place on Saturday, June 1 on westbound S.R. 200 at the underpass of Interstate 95 and on the southbound ramps of Interstate 95 to repair asphalt. Traffic conditions will be monitored during these necessary closures.

Daytime lane closures:

Interstate 95:

- The inside, southbound travel lane of Interstate 95 near exit 373 is expected to be closed daily from 9 a.m. until 3:30 p.m. Monday, June 3 through Thursday, June 6. The interstate ramps will not be impacted.
- The inside, northbound travel lane of Interstate 95 near exit 373 is expected to be closed daily from 9 a.m. until 3:30 p.m. Monday, June 3 through Thursday, June 6. The interstate ramps will not be impacted.

Nighttime lane closures:

Interstate 95:

- Southbound Interstate 95 lane closures are expected near exit 373 nightly, from 7 p.m. until 5:30 a.m. Sunday, June 2 through Thursday, June 6. The work is associated with the Interstate median and Interstate inside shoulder. Note: this activity may require multi-lane closures on Interstate 95. No ramps will be impacted

State Road 200:

- The westbound right lane of S.R. 200 from Eric Oliver Way to Meadowfield Bluffs Road will be closed from 9 p.m. until 6 a.m. Saturday, June 1 and again, nightly Monday, June 3 through Friday, June 7.

- The eastbound left turn lane of S.R. 200 onto Gene Lasserre Boulevard will be closed from 6 p.m. to 6 a.m. Saturday, June 1 and again, nightly from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. Monday, June 3 through Friday, June 7.
- The eastbound left turn lane of S.R. 200 onto Chester Road will be closed nightly Monday, June 3 through Wednesday June 5 from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- The westbound right turn lane of S.R. 200 onto Chester Road will be closed nightly Monday, June 3 through Wednesday June 5 from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.

Chester Road:

- The southbound left turn lane of Chester Road at S.R. 200 will be closed nightly Monday, June 3 through Wednesday, June 5 from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.

Gene Lasserre Boulevard:

Note: These construction activities do not require a detour; traffic will be shifted during the lane closures.

- The southbound right turn lane of Gene Lasserre Boulevard at S.R. 200 will be closed Saturday, May 1 from 6 p.m. to 6 a.m. and again, nightly Monday, June 3 through Friday, June 7 from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- The southbound, left lane of Gene Lasserre Boulevard at S.R. 200 will be closed Thursday, June 6 from 9 p.m. until 6 a.m.
- The northbound lane of Gene Lasserre Boulevard at S.R. 200 will be closed Friday, June 7 from 9 p.m. until 6 a.m.

Nassau County Advisory: While unrelated to the S.R. 200 corridor, interested parties may appreciate the following information:

The Florida Department of Transportation is scheduled to temporarily close a portion of County Road 121/Baldwin and Saint George Road between Turkey Trot Trail and Carroll Corner Road in mid-July 2019. The closure will be in place until rehabilitation work is completed on a bridge culvert damaged from erosion. Northbound and southbound drivers on County Road 121 will detour to U.S. 301 via County Road 108 and Henry Smith Road.
