# Travel Advisory: State Road 200 Lane Closure Schedule

**Yulee, Fla.** – This advisory is to inform community leaders and interested parties about upcoming, scheduled lane closures, traffic shifts and other construction activity on State Road 200/A1A. For a complete list of scheduled lane closures in northeast Florida, interested parties may visit: www.NFLRoads.com/TrafficReport.

Drivers can also setup real-time traffic alerts from FL511, a free service offered by the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT). Motorists can visit <a href="www.FL511.com">www.FL511.com</a> or call #511 for this up-to-date information.

The Florida Department of Transportation has permitted multiple lane closures as part of the State Road 200/A1A (S.R. 200) improvement projects. Below are several planned lane closures, weather permitting, planned for June 15 through June 21. Certain activities may require unexpected lane closures for the safety of both drivers and construction workers.

<u>Notable:</u> A detour planned for the Northbound I-95 ramp to State Road 200 is scheduled for Monday, June 24 from midnight to 5 a.m. Signage has recently been placed along the roadway to alert motorists of the expected detour. The detour route will divert traffic the next Interstate exit, U.S. 17, to travel south to S.R. 200. The detour is necessary for crews to install an overhead sign structure. An additional press release will be distributed next week.

A traffic shift is expected to take place on State Road 200 near Lofton Creek within the next 30 days, weather and schedule permitting. An additional press release will be distributed once the traffic shift dates are finalized.

## **Daytime lane closures:**

## **Interstate 95:**

- The inside, southbound travel lane of Interstate 95 near exit 373 is expected to be closed daily from 9 a.m. until 3:30 p.m. Monday, June 17 through Thursday, June 20. The interstate ramps will not be impacted.
- The inside, northbound travel lane of Interstate 95 near exit 373 is expected to be closed daily from 9 a.m. until 3:30 p.m. Monday, June 17 through Thursday, June 20. The interstate ramps will not be impacted.

#### State Road 200:

• Multiple eastbound and westbound inside lane closures are expected to take place at various locations along State Road 200 between 7 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Saturday, June 15. Drivers are encouraged to plan ahead.

## **Nighttime lane closures:**

### **Interstate 95:**

Southbound Interstate 95 lane closures are expected near exit 373 nightly, from 7 p.m. until 5:30 a.m. Sunday, June 16 through Thursday, June 20. The work is associated with the Interstate median and Interstate inside shoulder. Note: this activity may require multi-lane closures on Interstate 95. The Interstate ramps will not be impacted.

### **State Road 200:**


- The eastbound left turn lane of S.R. 200 onto Chester Road will be closed nightly, Monday, June 17 through Friday, June 21 from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- The westbound right lane of S.R. 200 in the vicinity of Chester Road will be closed nightly, Monday, June 17 through Friday, June 21 from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.

### **Chester Road:**

• The southbound left turn lane of Chester Road onto eastbound S.R. 200 will be closed nightly, Monday, June 17 through Friday, June 21 from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.

<u>Nassau County Advisory:</u> While unrelated to the S.R. 200 corridor, interested parties may appreciate the following information:

The Florida Department of Transportation is scheduled to temporarily close a portion of County Road 121/Baldwin and Saint George Road between Turkey Trot Trail and Carroll Corner Road in mid-July 2019. The closure will be in place until rehabilitation work is completed on a bridge culvert damaged from erosion. Northbound and southbound drivers on County Road 121 will detour to U.S. 301 via County Road 108 and Henry Smith Road.
