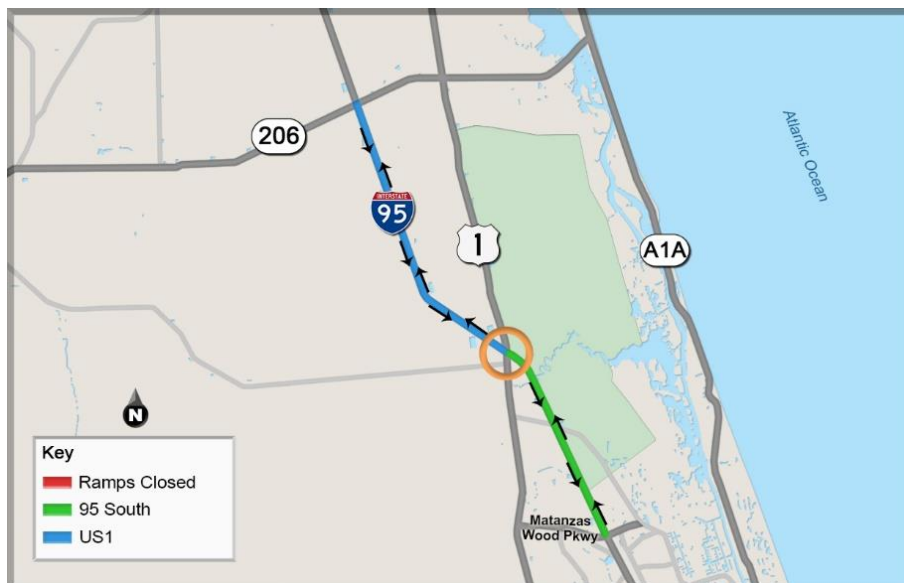

U.S. 1 Ramp at I-95 to Close Overnight for Resurfacing Work

ST. AUGUSTINE, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will temporarily close the I-95 southbound entrance and exit ramps at U.S. 1 tomorrow night, March 30 through Thursday night, April 1 from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., weather and schedule permitting.

As shown in the map below, drivers attempting to exit I-95 southbound at U.S. 1 will be detoured south to the Matanzas Woods Parkway exit back onto I-95 northbound, where they can access U.S. 1.

Drivers attempting to enter I-95 southbound from U.S. 1 will be detoured onto I-95 northbound to the State Road 206 exit, where they can access I-95 southbound.
