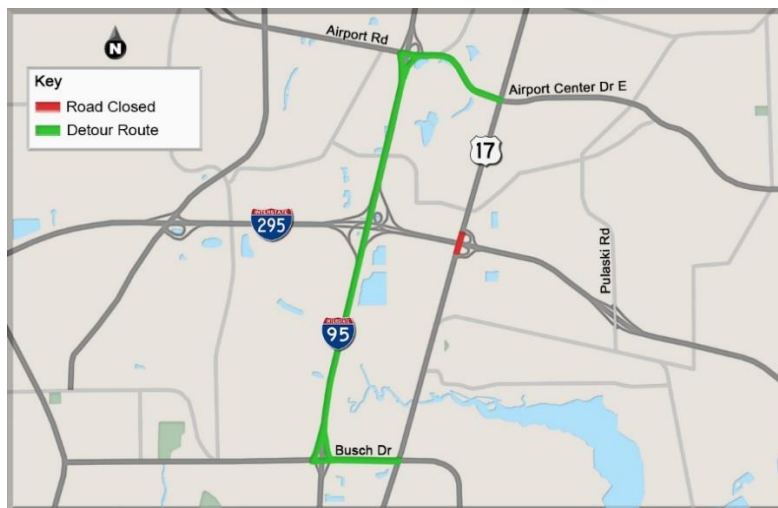

U.S. 17 to Be Detoured Tonight for I-295 North Interchange Project

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation will temporarily detour traffic on U.S. 17 between Eastport Road and New Berlin Road tonight, March 25, from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. as part of the I-95/I-295 North Interchange Improvement Project.

As shown in the map below, drivers attempting to travel southbound on U.S. 17 will be detoured to Airport Road onto southbound I-95 to the Busch Drive exit, where they can rejoin U.S. 17. Drivers attempting to travel northbound on U.S. 17 will be detoured to Busch Drive to northbound I-95 to the Airport Road exit, where they can rejoin U.S. 17.



This work is part of the I-95/I-295 North Interchange Operational Improvement project that includes a new collector-distributor system, auxiliary lanes and ramp improvements. The interchange is part of an important corridor to promote economic growth and development in the region.
