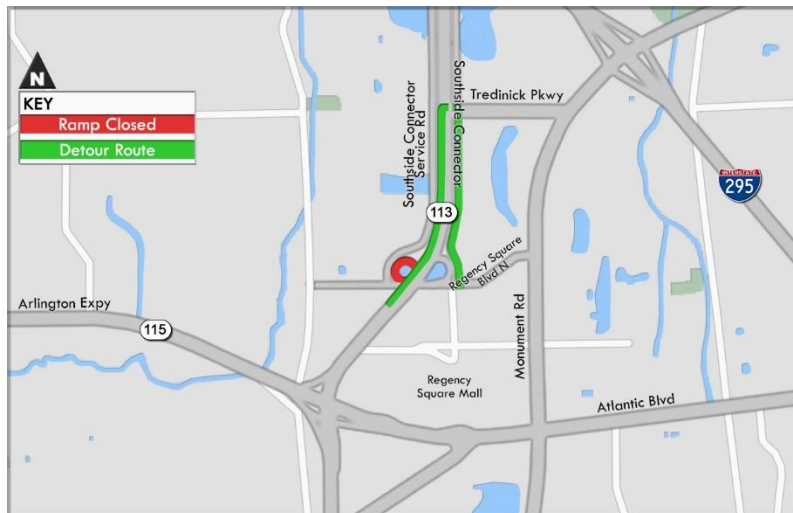

UPDATE: Southside Connector On-Ramp at Regency Square Boulevard North closed Wednesday through Friday

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – The Southside Connector (State Road 113) southbound on-ramp from Regency Square Boulevard North has been rescheduled to close Wednesday, January 13, through Friday, January 15, from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. for work related to the Southside Connector resurfacing and improvement project.

Southbound Southside Connector traffic will detour via the Southside Connector Service roads (north and south) to and from Tredinick Parkway. (Detour and closure shown in map below.)
