

## Westbound Mathews Bridge Closed Friday Night through Monday Morning, Oct. 14 to 17

*Westbound traffic will detour to the Hart Bridge*

**JACKSONVILLE, Fla.** – Westbound lanes of the Mathews Bridge (State Road 10A) will close Friday night, Oct. 14, at 9 p.m. and reopen Monday morning, Oct. 17 by 6 a.m. for work related to the Mathews Bridge repair project. Westbound Mathews Bridge traffic will detour to the Hart Bridge via Cesery Boulevard and Atlantic Boulevard.

The Mathews Bridge repair project includes localized bridge truss painting and steel rehabilitation. The \$8.1 million project is scheduled to be completed in summer 2023, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
