Wonderwood Drive from Sand Castle Lane to Mayport Road resurfacing and improvements starting soon

Jacksonville – The Florida Department of Transportation will resurface and improve Wonderwood Drive (State Road 116) from Sand Castle Lane to Mayport Road starting January 8, weather and schedule permitting.

The project consists of resurfacing approximately one mile of roadway and improving pedestrian safety along the corridor. Pedestrian safety improvements include enhanced crosswalks, the installation of countdown pedestrian signals and upgrading sidewalks and handicap-accessible ramps at various intersections including A1A and Mayport Road. In addition, new concrete pads will be installed at nine existing JTA bus stops along the route.

Construction will occur weekdays with occasional weekend work. Eastbound lane closures are not permitted from 8 p.m. to 9 a.m. and westbound lane closures are not permitted from 2 p.m. to 7 a.m. Monday through Friday. No lane closures are allowed from 8 p.m. to 10 a.m. on Saturday and Sunday.

The \$1.6 million project is scheduled for completion in summer 2018, schedule and weather permitting. Preferred Materials, Inc. is the contractor.
