Work to Start Soon on Blanding Boulevard Traffic Signal Upgrades

Jacksonville – Work is expected to begin August 20 on a project to complete traffic signal upgrades and other improvements at seven intersections along Blanding Boulevard (State Road 21) in Duval County.

The project involves new traffic signals at Du-Clay Road, Morse Avenue, 118th Street, 105th Street, Cedar Hills Boulevard/Confederate Point Road, San Juan Avenue and Shirley Avenue. Construction will also include base work and upgrades to curb and gutter, lighting, highway signage and sidewalks.

Contractor Conti Corporation is expected to complete the \$2.9 million project in spring 2019, weather and schedule permitting.

Traffic will be maintained in accordance with FDOT design standards throughout the project, with existing posted speed limits remaining in place. Most work is expected to take place Monday through Friday between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. No lane closures will be permitted between 7 a.m. and 8 p.m., seven days per week. Lane closure notices will be available at www.nflroads.com.
