

Yellow Water Road Closed at Rebar Road May 21 through May 24

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – Yellow Water Road (County Road 217) at Rebar Road will be closed from Friday, May 21 at 5 p.m. to Monday, May 24 at 6 a.m. for work related to the Yellow Water Road Bridge replacement project.

Traffic north and south of the closure will detour using Beaver Street (U.S. 90), U.S. 301 and Normandy Boulevard (State Road 228).
