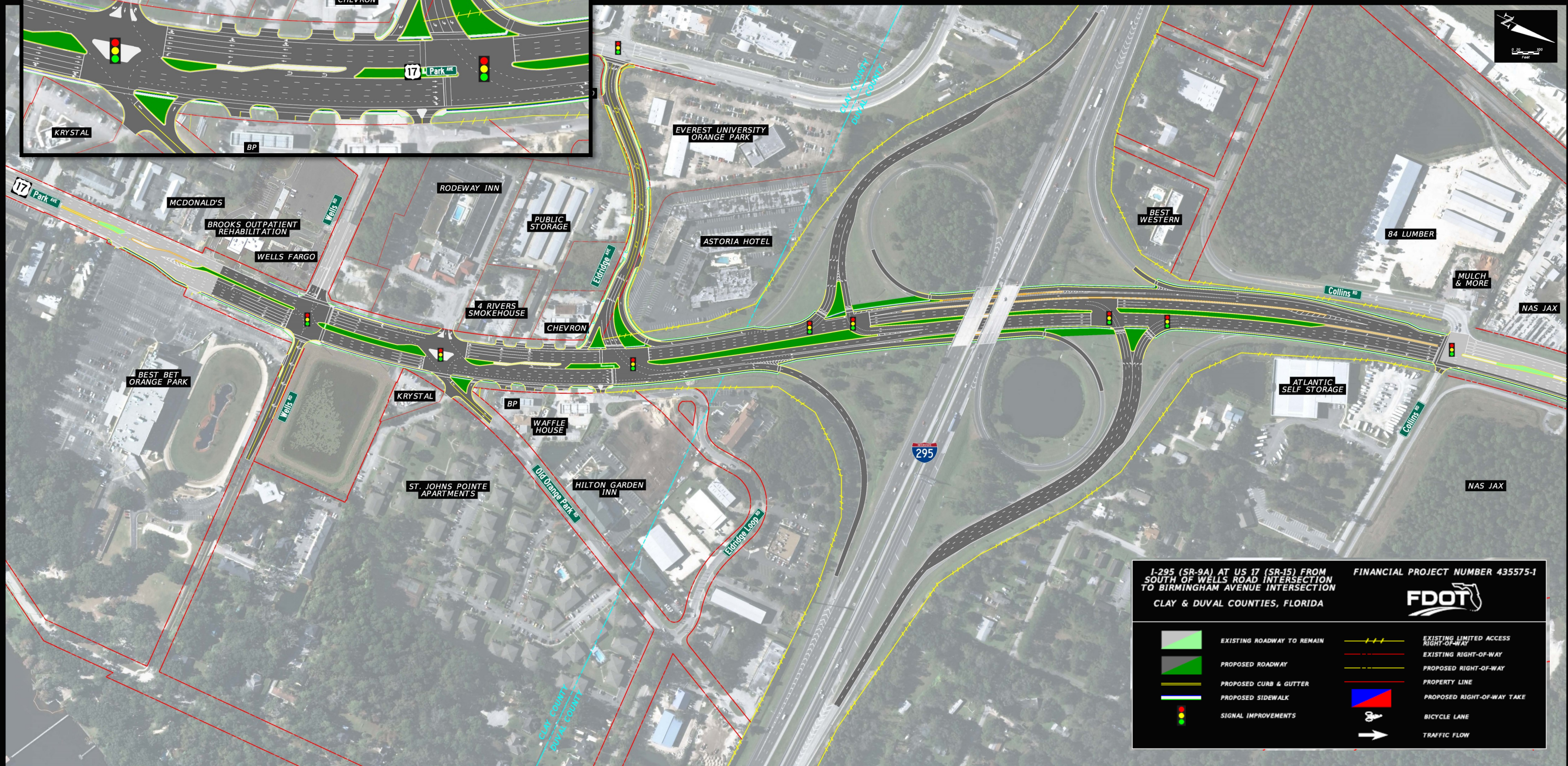

Welcome to the Florida Department of Transportation's (FDOT) public meeting. The Department is conducting a Project Development & Environment (PD&E) Study for proposed widening and reconstruction of US 17 from Collins Road in Duval County to south of Wells Road in Clay County.

Traffic operations within the project study area show excessive delay and heavy queuing at the intersections along US 17 during peak hours as well as at the on and off-ramps to I-295. With expectations of continued traffic operations issues, this PD&E study is investigating alternatives to meet capacity needs, intersection operations and safety within the study area.




