The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) invites you to attend a hybrid public meeting on **Thursday**, **November 3**, **2022**, **4 to 6 p.m.**, to discuss permit-related median modifications at the intersection of Atlantic Boulevard (State Road 10) and Sutton Lakes Boulevard.

The meeting will be held in-person at the FDOT Training Facility at 2198 Edison Avenue, Jacksonville, FL 32204 and virtually via **nflroads.com/VPH**. Participants can also call 562-247-8321, using code 410-003-544, to access the meeting by phone. FDOT staff and the permit applicant will be available to answer questions and concerns during the open house period. Public comments will begin at 6 p.m.

The changes include modifying the signal at Sutton Lakes Boulevard to accommodate a new permitted roadway on the north side of Atlantic Boulevard between Duval Acura and Land Rover. (See rendering on back.)

Participants wishing to submit comments regarding the median modifications may do so at the meeting via a statement for the public record or in writing.
