ABOUT THE PROJECT

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) proposes to add traffic separator to NW 39th Avenue (SR 222) along both the eastbound and westbound left turn lanes to NW 13th Street.

FDOT proposes the following modifications:

- Construct a traffic separator along the eastbound 39th Avenue left turn-lane to 13th Street
- Construct a traffic separator along the westbound 39th Avenue left turn-lane to 13th Street
- Extend the existing eastbound and westbound left turn-lanes from 39th Avenue to 13th Street
