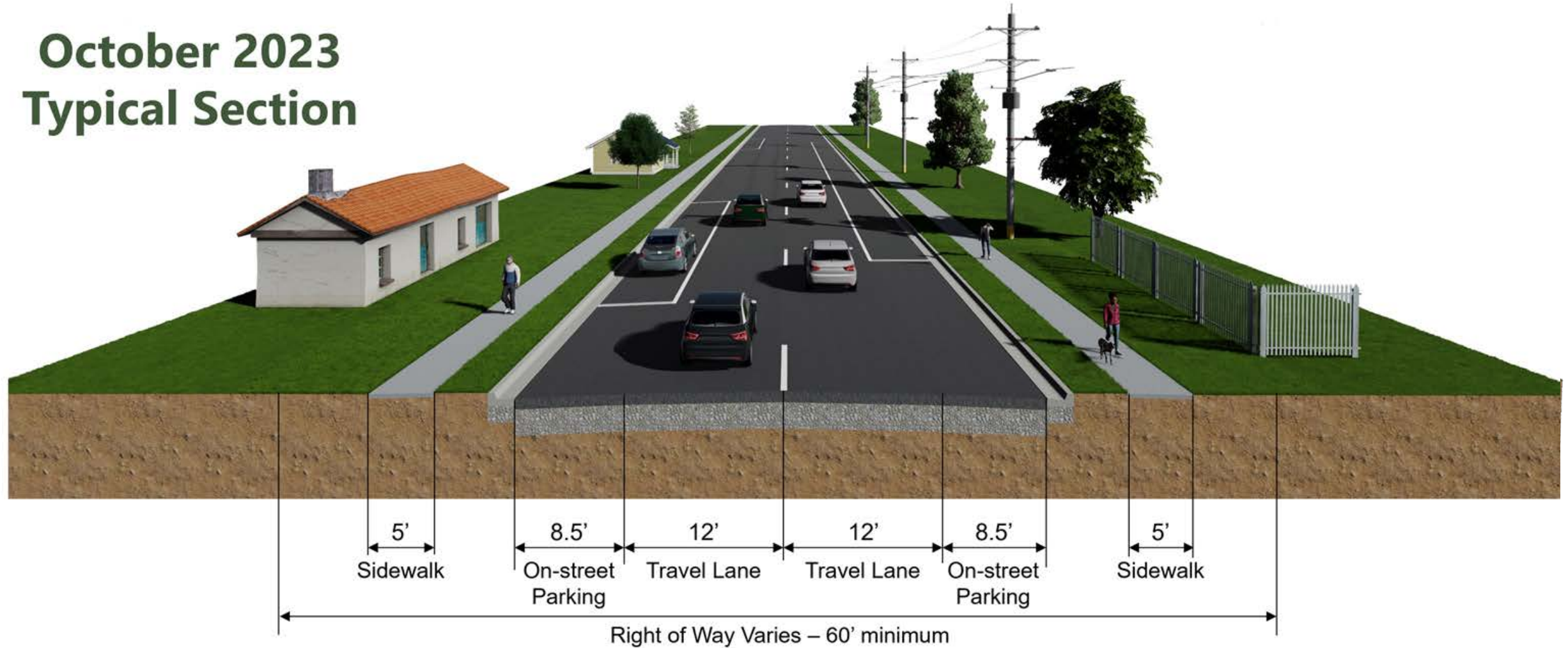

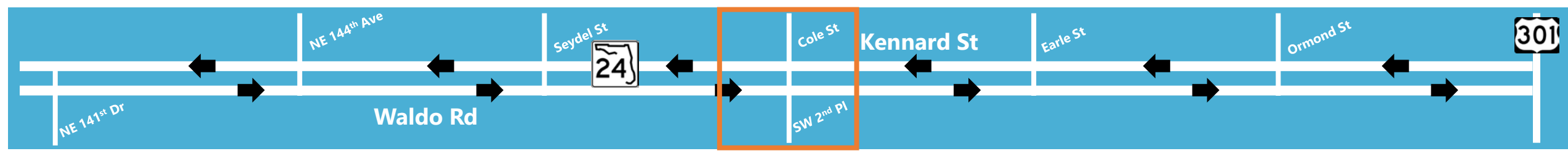

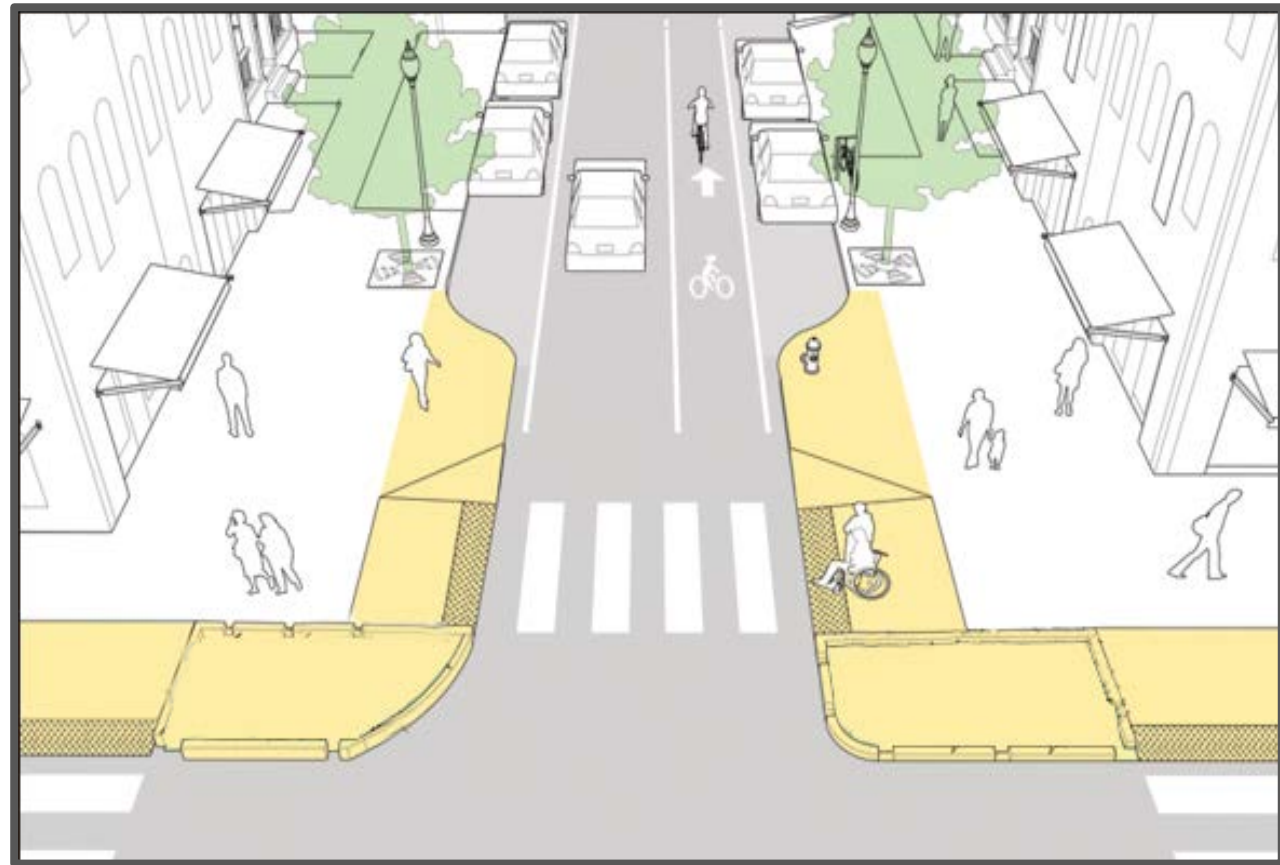

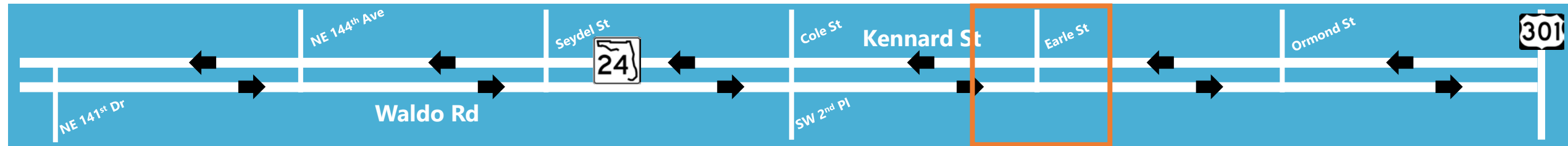


Proposed Intersection





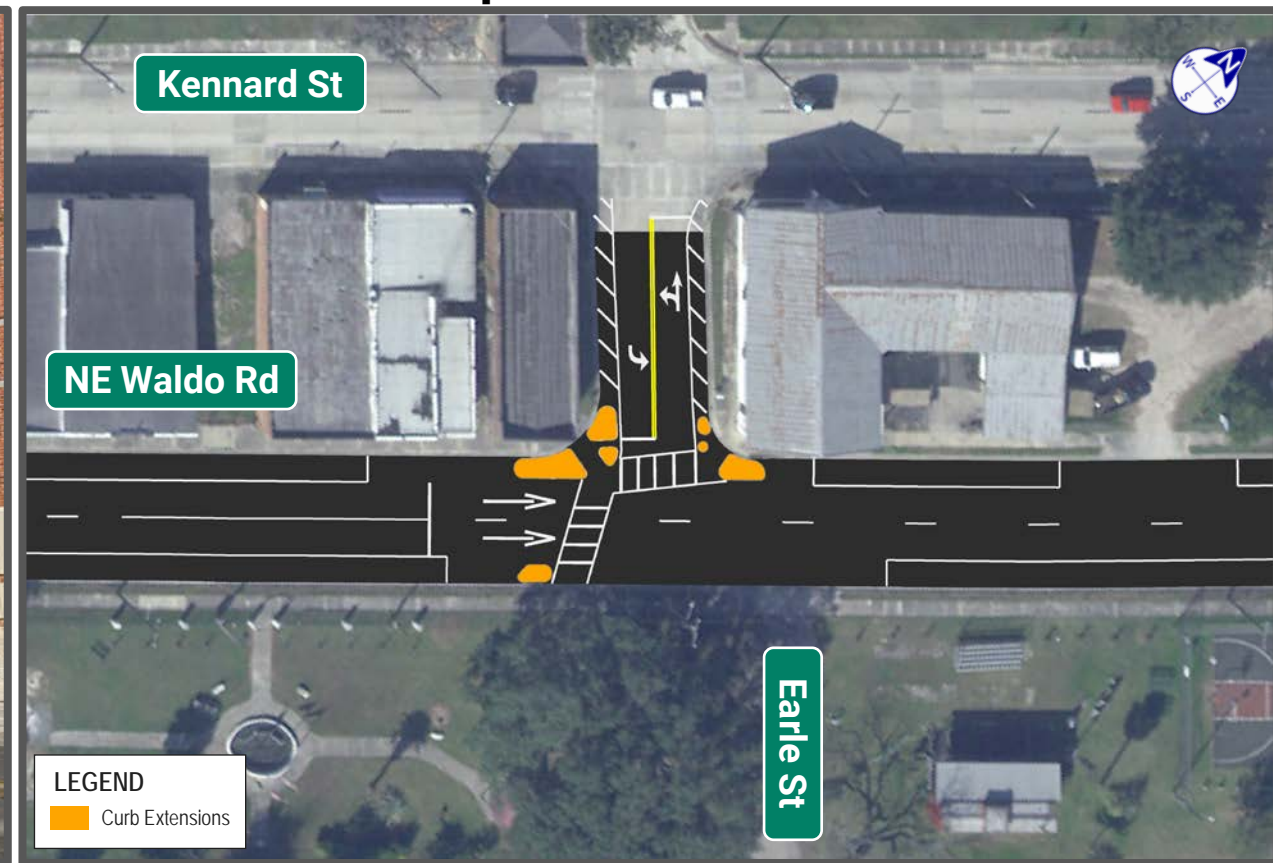

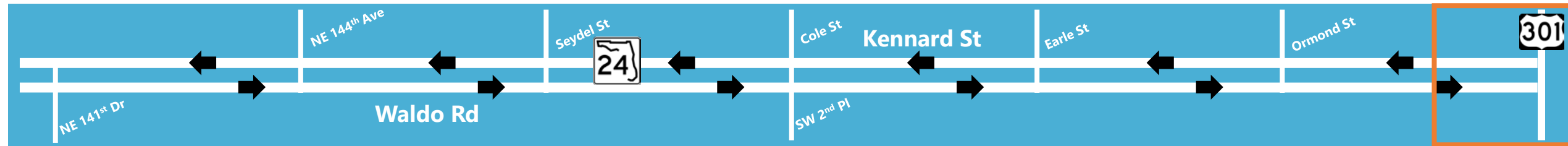
Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacon

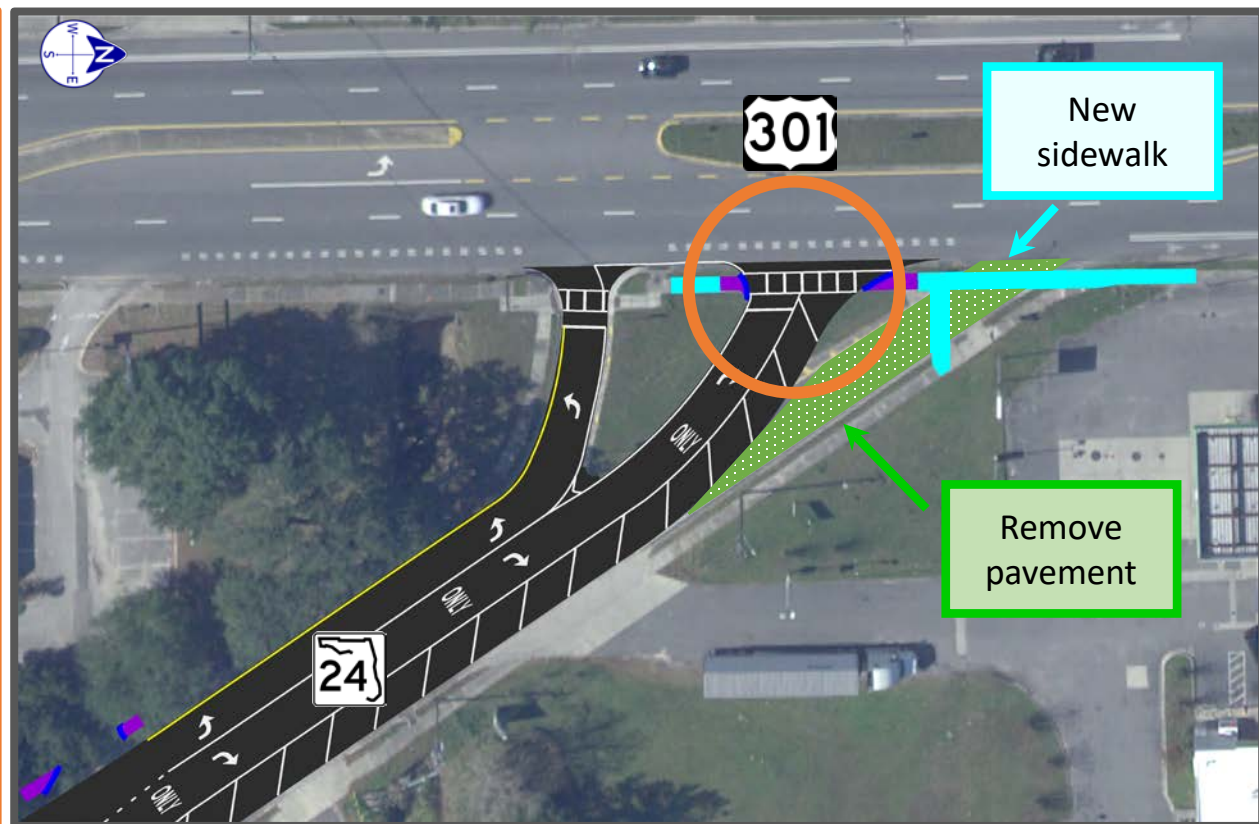
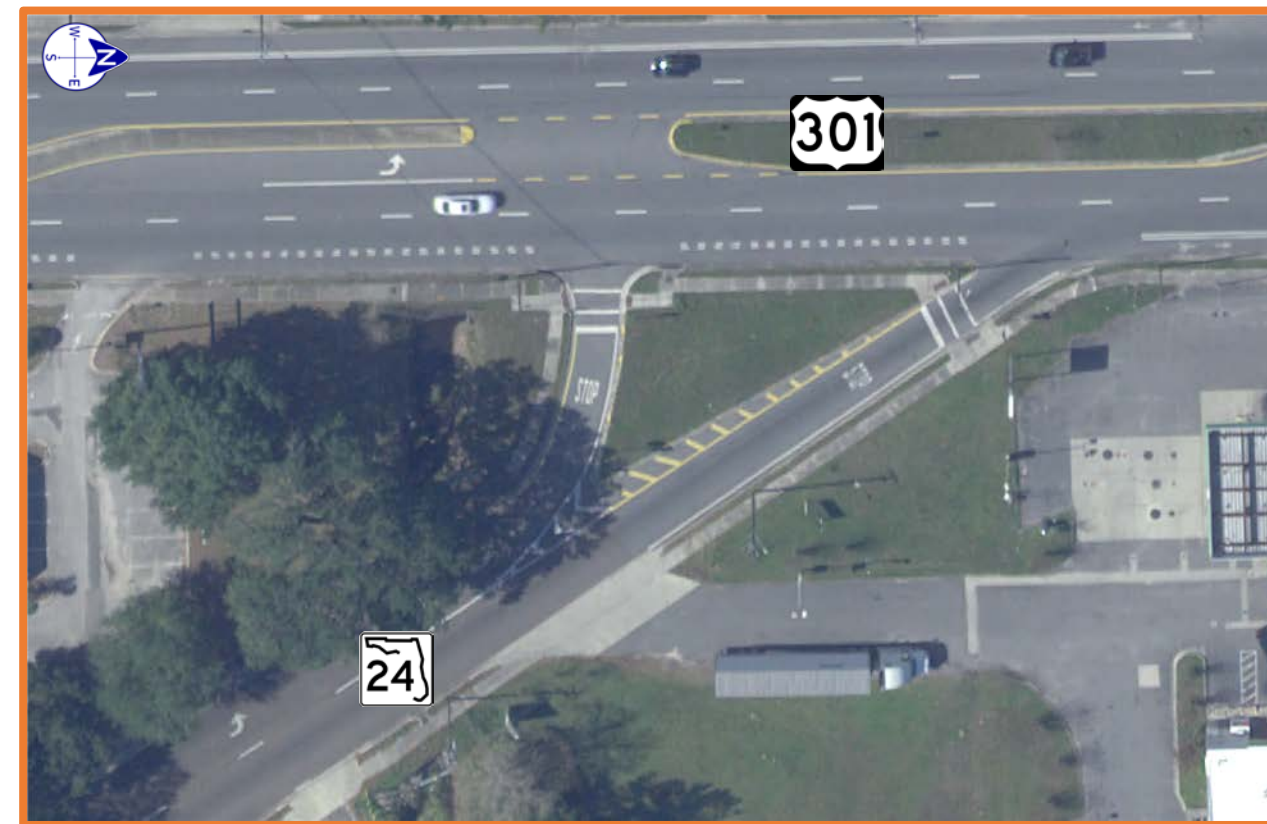


Realigned SR 24/US 301 Intersection

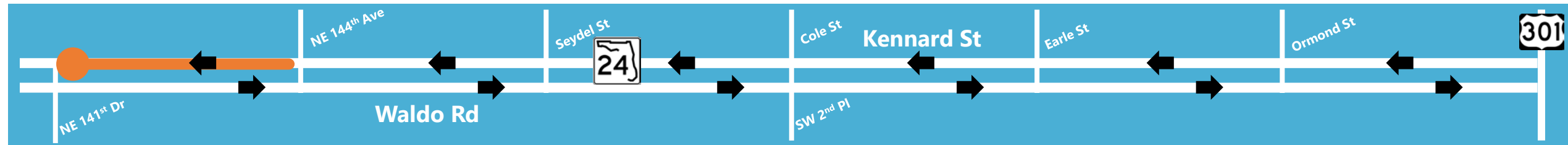


Existing Intersection
