### **Continuous Slip Ramp Closure from Northbound Southside Boulevard to Eastbound Atlantic Boulevard Scheduled June 24 to July 3**

**JACKSONVILLE, Fla.** – As part of the intersection improvement project on Southside Boulevard (SR 115) at Atlantic Boulevard (SR 10), a continuous slip ramp closure from northbound Southside Boulevard to eastbound Atlantic Boulevard is scheduled for Monday, June 24 at 12 a.m. to Wednesday, July 3 at 12 a.m. as the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) continues the resurfacing project.

Maer Homes, LLC was selected to complete the \$1.8 million project, which includes milling and resurfacing, base work, drainage improvements, curb and gutters, traffic signals, highway signing, sidewalks, and other incidental construction. Completion is estimated in summer 2024, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting. During construction, the public is encouraged to follow pedestrian detour signs and use caution in the area.
