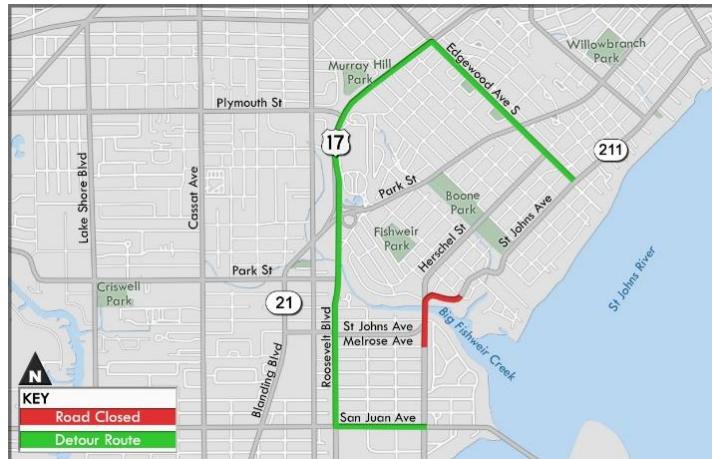

Detours Planned for State Road 211 Intersection Improvements Project

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation will implement detours to perform concrete operations as part of the State Road 211 (St. Johns Avenue) from Herschel Street to Canterbury Street Intersection Improvements Project.

State Road 211 (St. Johns Avenue) at Herschel Street Detour:

- Thursday, April 28 at 7 p.m. through Sunday, May 2 at 5 a.m., weather and schedule permitting, St. Johns Avenue at Herschel Street will be closed to traffic from Melrose Avenue to Canterbury Avenue. Traffic will be detoured to San Juan Avenue to Roosevelt Boulevard and Edgewood Avenue South.
