FDOT to Host Nov. 4 Public Hearing for Proposed Improvements to U.S. 17 from South of New Berlin Road to Airport Center Drive

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will host an in-person public hearing to discuss proposed improvements for U.S. 17 from south of New Berlin Road to Airport Center Drive on Monday, Nov. 4 from 4:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. at the Hilton Garden Inn Jacksonville Airport, located at 13503 Ranch Road, Jacksonville, Florida 32218. This subsequent in-person public hearing was rescheduled from Sept. 26, 2024, to Nov. 4, 2024, due to inclement weather associated with Hurricane Helene.

The hearing serves to inform the public of the proposed improvements and provide an opportunity for the public to express opinions and concerns regarding the project.

Draft project documents and other information are available for public review at the Highlands Regional Library, located at 1826 Dunn Avenue, Jacksonville, FL 32218, and at the FDOT Jacksonville Urban Office, located at 2198 Edison Avenue, Jacksonville, FL 32204, as well as on the project website at www.nflroads.com/US17.

The environmental review, consultation, and other actions required by applicable federal environmental laws for this project are being, or have been, carried-out by the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) pursuant to 23 U.S.C. § 327 and a Memorandum of Understanding dated May 26, 2022, and executed by the Federal Highway Administration and FDOT.
