ICYMI: FDOT to Host July 10 Hybrid Access Management Public Meeting for Proposed Safety Improvements to State Road 20 and Reid Street in Palatka

PALATKA, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will host a public meeting to discuss proposed safety improvements on State Road 20 at Crill Avenue and Morris Street. FDOT will additionally discuss proposed safety improvements on Reid Street (U.S. 17/State Road 15) from the Memorial Bridge to Madison Street.

The hybrid public meeting will be held Wednesday, July 10 at the Palatka City Hall Commissions Chamber located at 201 N. Second Street, Palatka, FL 32177. Project staff will be available to answer questions and accept comments in person or online at www.nflroads.com/VPH.

Citizens may attend anytime between 4:30 p.m. and 6 p.m. to learn more about the scope of the project improvements, offer input and view conceptual renderings of the projects. A formal presentation and public comment period for both in-person and virtual participants will begin at 6 p.m.
