Multiple Overnight and Daytime Lane and Ramp Closures Planned for Southside Connector Sunday through Friday

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – Lanes and ramps on the Southside Connector (State Road 113) from I-295 to Atlantic Boulevard/Arlington Expressway (State Road 115), including the Merrill Road (State Road 116) and Regency Square Boulevard North interchanges, will be closed at various times during the day and night Sunday, March 20 through Friday, March 25. The closures, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting, are needed to facilitate paving activities related to the Southside Connector resurfacing project.

Signage and digital message boards will direct motorists through the closures and detours.

March is bicycle safety month. When cycling always wear a helmet and ride in the same direction of traffic on the street. Obey all traffic signs, signals, and markings.
