Overnight Closures of Blanding Boulevard Planned June 24-27 for First Coast Expressway Construction

CLAY COUNTY, Fla. – As part of First Coast Expressway construction, overnight closures of Blanding Boulevard (State Road 21) are planned Monday, June 24 through Thursday, June 27, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

Blanding Boulevard from County Road 220 to Baxley Road will close nightly Monday, June 24 through Thursday, June 27 for scuppers installation and deck pouring. Closures will be in place from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. the following morning. During the closures, traffic will detour via County Road 220 and Baxley Road.
