Overnight Detour of Westbound Arlington Expressway Planned Next Week

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – As part of a resurfacing project on Arlington Expressway (State Road 115) from Mathews Bridge to Southside Boulevard, westbound Arlington Expressway is set to close at 9 p.m. Friday, May 31 and reopen by 6 a.m. Sunday, June 2 while crews perform concrete paving rehabilitation. During the closure, drivers will detour via westbound South Service Road to access the Arlington Expressway.

Superior Construction is expected to complete the \$26 million project in summer 2024, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
