### **Overnight Detours Planned Next Week at the State Road 207 Ramps to and from I-95**

**ST. AUGUSTINE, Fla.** – As part of resurfacing improvements on I-95 from State Road 207 to International Golf Parkway, closures of the State Road 207 ramps to and from I-95 are necessary for shoulder treatment work to be completed. The closures are scheduled for the overnight hours between 8 p.m. and 6 a.m.

- **Sunday, June 2:** The State Road 207 ramp to I-95 North will close overnight. During the closure, drivers on State Road 207 seeking to access I-95 North will use I-95 South and exit at State Road 206 to access I-95 North.
- **Monday, June 3:** The State Road 207 exit ramp from I-95 North will close overnight. During the closure, drivers on I-95 North seeking to access State Road 207 will instead exit at State Road 16 to I-95 South to access State Road 207.
- **Tuesday, June 4:** The State Road 207 ramp to I-95 South will close overnight. During the closure, drivers on State Road 207 seeking to access I-95 South will use I-95 North and exit at State Road 16 to access I-95 South.
- **Wednesday, June 5:** The State Road 207 exit ramp from I-95 South will close overnight. During the closure, drivers on I-95 South seeking to access State Road 207 will instead exit at State Road 206 to I-95 North to access State Road 207.

Drivers are encouraged to use caution in the area and follow posted detour signs at these times. Anderson Columbia Co. Inc. is estimated to complete the \$31 million resurfacing improvements by early 2025, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
