Overnight Detours Scheduled from Nov. 17 to Nov. 21 as Part of FDOT's I-10 Widening Project

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – As part of FDOT's I-10 from I-295 to I-95 widening project, overnight closures and detours are scheduled at multiple interchanges within the project limits beginning Sunday, Nov. 17 while crews perform bridge construction operations, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

Please note that schedules may be adjusted to avoid conflicting detour traffic along the routes.

Nightly scheduled closures Sunday, Nov. 17 until Tuesday Nov. 19, from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. the following morning:

- **I-10 West exit to U.S. 17 closed:** Drivers will detour to the McDuff Avenue exit and travel south to connect with U.S. 17 and continue toward their destination.
- **U.S. 17 on-ramp to I-10 East closed:** Drivers will detour to Roosevelt Boulevard, to Edgewood Avenue, to Plymouth Street and take McDuff Avenue to connect with I-10 East.

Nightly scheduled closures Sunday, Nov. 17 until Thursday Nov. 21, from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. the following morning:

- **McDuff Avenue on-ramp to I-10 West closed:** Northbound drivers will detour to Lenox Avenue and take Cassat Avenue to connect with I-10 West. Southbound drivers will detour to Rosselle Street, to Stockton Street, to Irene Street, to Edison Avenue and take Forest Street to connect with I-10 West.

Nightly scheduled closures Wednesday, Nov. 20 and Thursday, Nov. 21 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. the following morning:

- **Irene Street on-ramp to I-10 West closed:** Drivers will detour to Edison Avenue and take Forest Street to connect with I-10 West.
- **I-10 West exit to McDuff Avenue closed:** Drivers will detour to Luna Street and take Lenox Avenue to connect with McDuff Avenue.
