### Overnight Detours on Edgewood Avenue Planned June 30 through July 3

**JACKSONVILLE, Fla.** – Nightly lane closures and detours will be in place on Edgewood Avenue from Post Street to Mayflower Street Sunday, June 30 through Wednesday, July 3 for paving operations. The closures will begin nightly at 9 p.m. and end by 6 a.m. the following morning, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting. During the closures, drivers should follow detour signage and use additional caution in the area.

Starting Sunday, June 30 Edgewood Avenue between Mayflower and Post will be closed from 9 p.m. until 6 a.m. the next morning, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting. Detours will be in place during overnight hours. During the closures, drivers should follow detour signage and use additional caution in the area.
