Overnight Detours Planned Next Week at I-95 North Ramp to State Road 16

ST. AUGUSTINE, Fla. – As part of the resurfacing improvements on I-95 from State Road 207 to International Golf Parkway, a closure of the State Road 16 exit ramp from I-95 north is necessary for drainage work to be completed. The ramp will close nightly at 8 p.m. and reopen by 6 a.m. the following morning Sunday, Jan. 29 through Tuesday, Jan 31.

During the closure, drivers will be detoured to exit at International Golf Parkway to I-95 south to State Road 16.

Anderson Columbia Co. Inc. is estimated to complete the \$31 million resurfacing improvements by winter 2023, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
