Rehabilitation and Resurfacing on I-95 St. Marys River Bridge Begins This Week

NASSAU COUNTY, Fla. – A project to rehabilitate and resurface the St. Marys River Bridge on I-95 at the Florida/Georgia state line begins this week. Improvements under this project include rehabilitation of the original fender system, removal of diaphragms, the addition of concrete deck overlay and other incidental construction.

Traffic will be maintained in accordance with FDOT design standards throughout the project. Drivers can expect single and double lane closures between 10 p.m. and 5 a.m. Monday through Friday. No lane closures will be allowed 6 p.m. Friday through 9 p.m. Sunday. No impact to marine traffic is expected.

Seacoast Inc. was awarded the \$5.94 million improvement project and is expected to complete work in summer 2025, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
