### **Roosevelt Boulevard Ramp to Edgewood Avenue Closures Planned June 3 to June 5**

**JACKSONVILLE, Fla.** – The southbound Roosevelt Boulevard (U.S. 17) ramp to Edgewood Avenue will be closed daily Monday, June 3 through Wednesday, June 5 between 6:30 a.m. and 5 p.m., weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

The closure will allow crews to perform routine maintenance on bridge joints on the Roosevelt Boulevard bridge.
