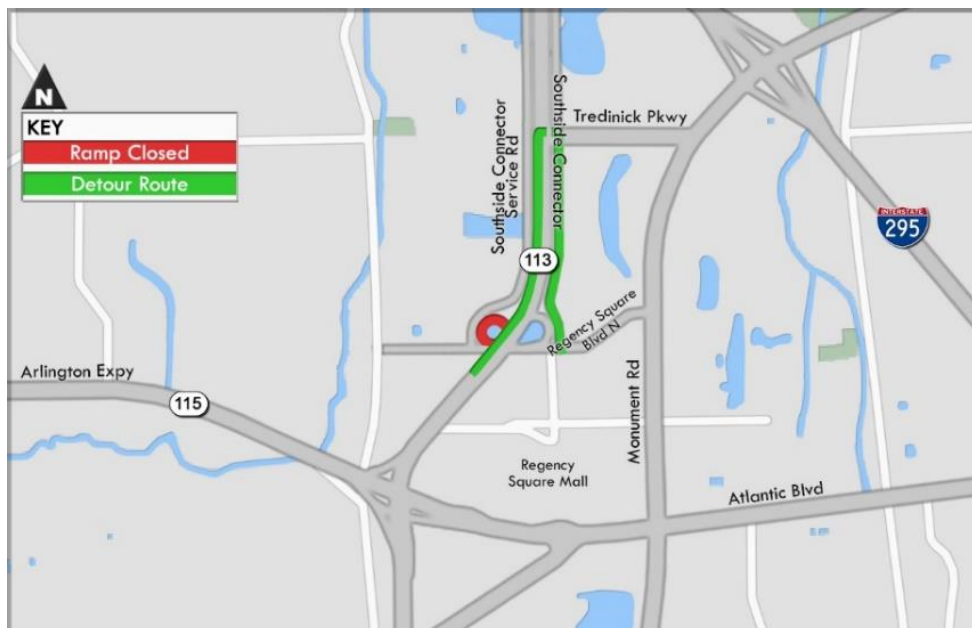

### Southside Connector Ramp at Regency Square Boulevard North Closed September 27 to September 28

**JACKSONVILLE, Fla.** – The Southside Connector (State Road 113) southbound on-ramp from Regency Square Boulevard North will close tonight, Monday, September 27 at 7 p.m. and reopen Tuesday, September 28 at 7 p.m., weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting. The closure is necessary for guardrail work associated with the Southside Connector resurfacing and improvement project.

Southside Connector southbound traffic will detour via the Southside Connector Service roads (north and south) to and from Tredinick Parkway to access Southside Connector southbound. (Closure and detour shown below.)
