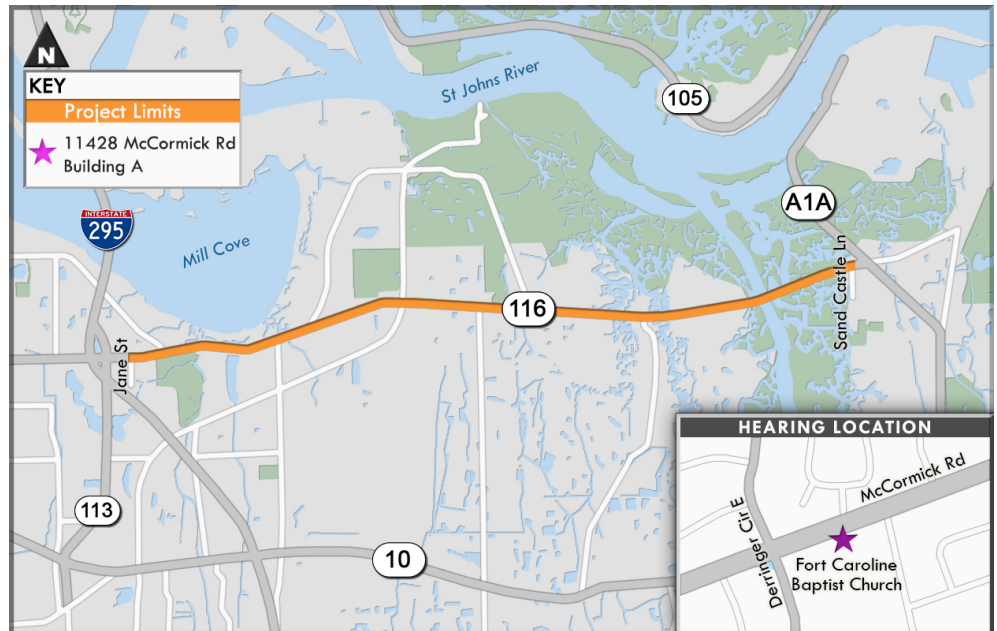

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) invites you to attend a construction Open House for the upcoming State Road 116 resurfacing and roadway improvement project that will be starting in April.

The informal Open House will give the public the opportunity to view roadway plans and discuss details with FDOT staff and the project team. Participants can stop in, attend virtually or call in anytime between 5 and 7 p.m. to learn more about the project. To attend virtually, please register online at nflroads.com/virtualmeetings. The project includes roadway resurfacing and improvements along seven miles of State Road 116, known along the route from east of I-295 to A1A as Merrill, Ft. Caroline, McCormick and Mt. Pleasant roads and Wonderwood Drive. The \$30 million project is scheduled to start in April and be completed in summer 2024. Single lane closures will be in effect along the corridor through the duration of the project.
