Rail Safety Improvements (209443-4)

- Intersection modification (elongated roundabout) at Post Street and Old Roosevelt
- Free-flow single intersection
- Updated signage, pavement markings
- Upgraded lighting, including crosswalk lighting
- Safety enhancements: pedestrian rail gate skirts, decreased gate lengths and camera detection with audible sound devices.
- ADA sidewalk improvements





Detour Route

- This is the detour route around construction.
- This detour will be placed upon construction start in Summer
 2025 and lifted once the build is complete.





Resurfacing Improvements (209443-2)

- Asphalt resurfacing on Post Street (SR 228) from Cassat Avenue to Old Roosevelt Boulevard
- Updated signage
- New pavement markings
- ADA sidewalk improvements
