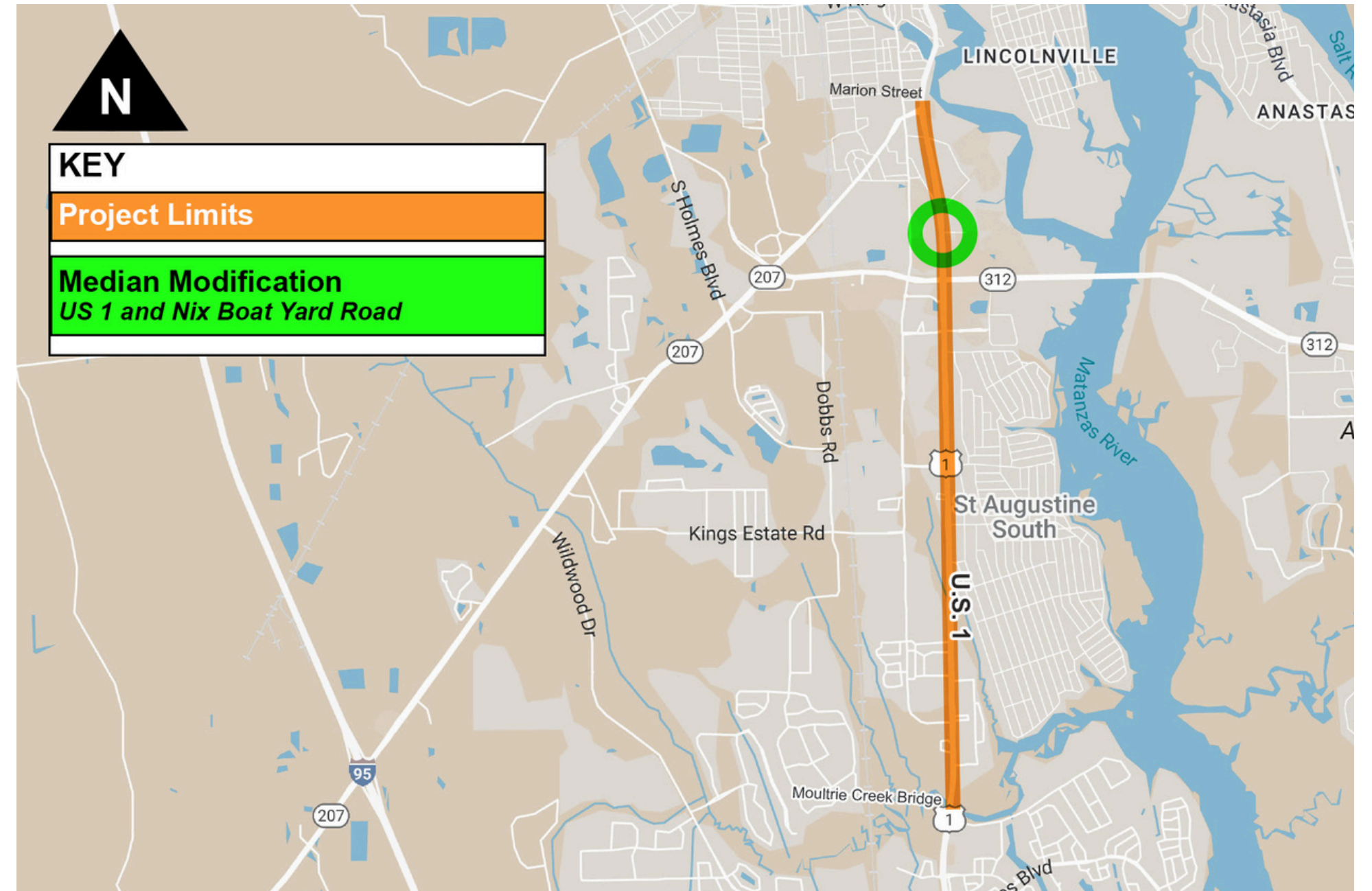

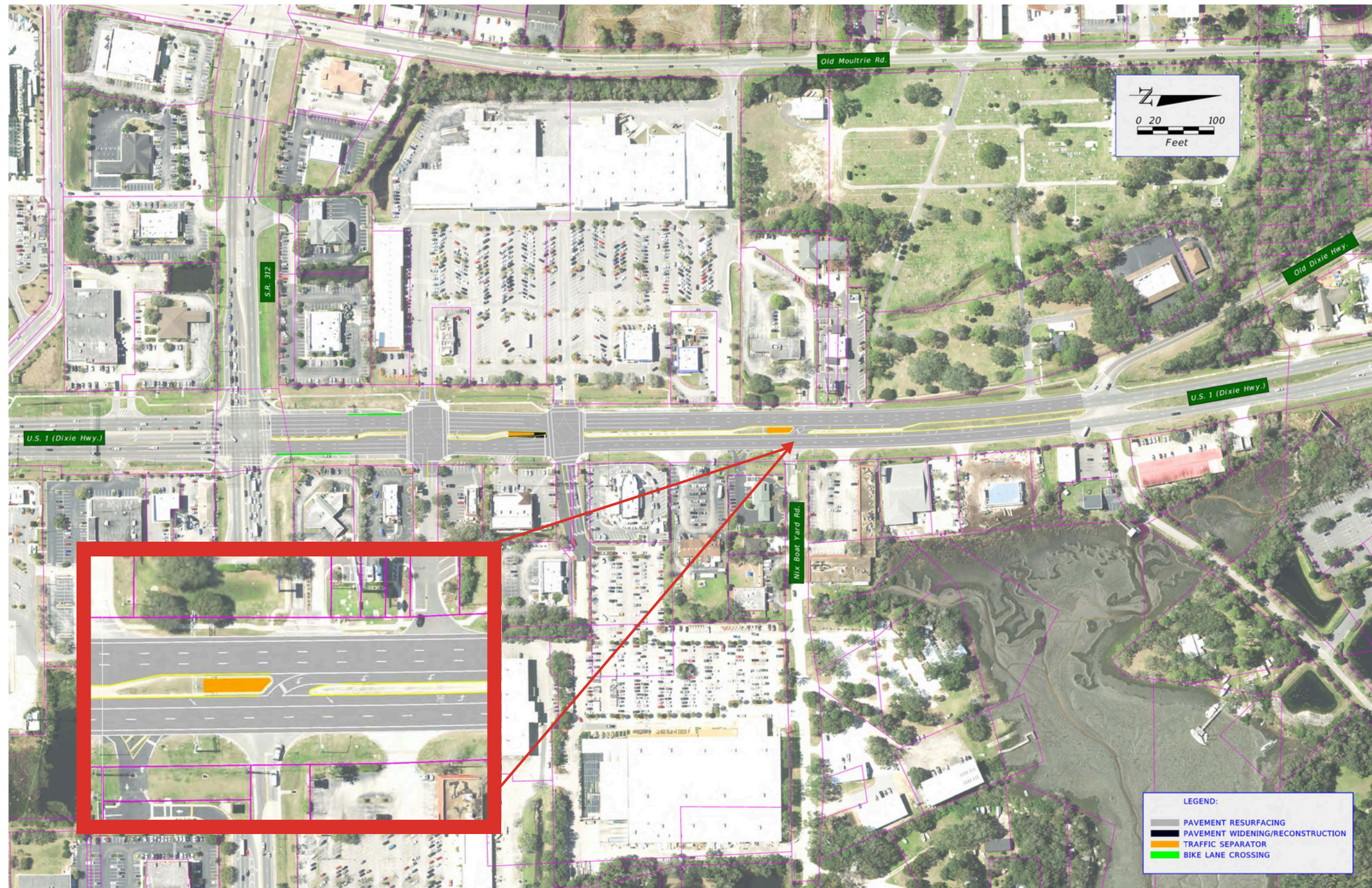

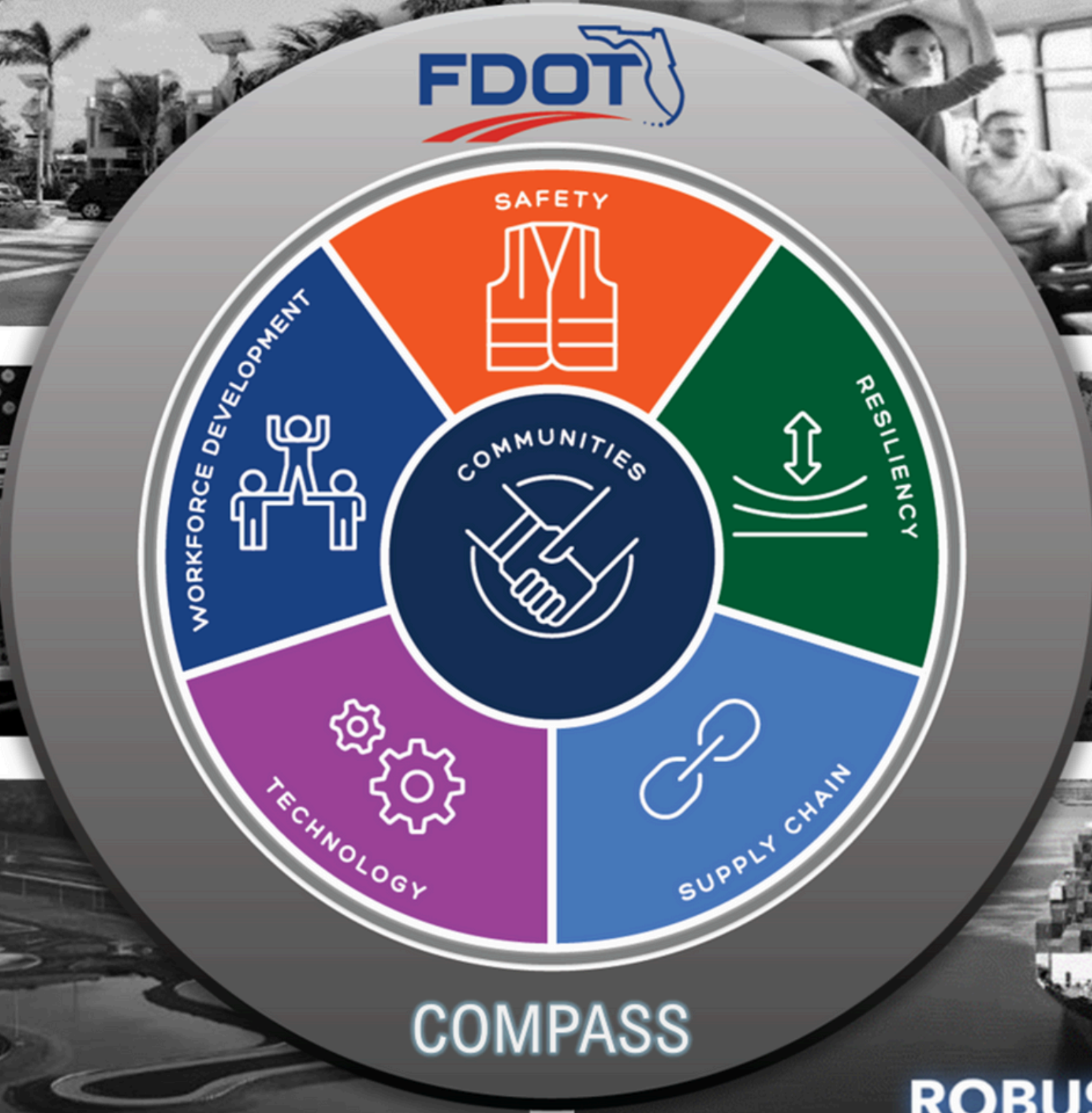
### Virtual Construction Open House and Public Meeting
