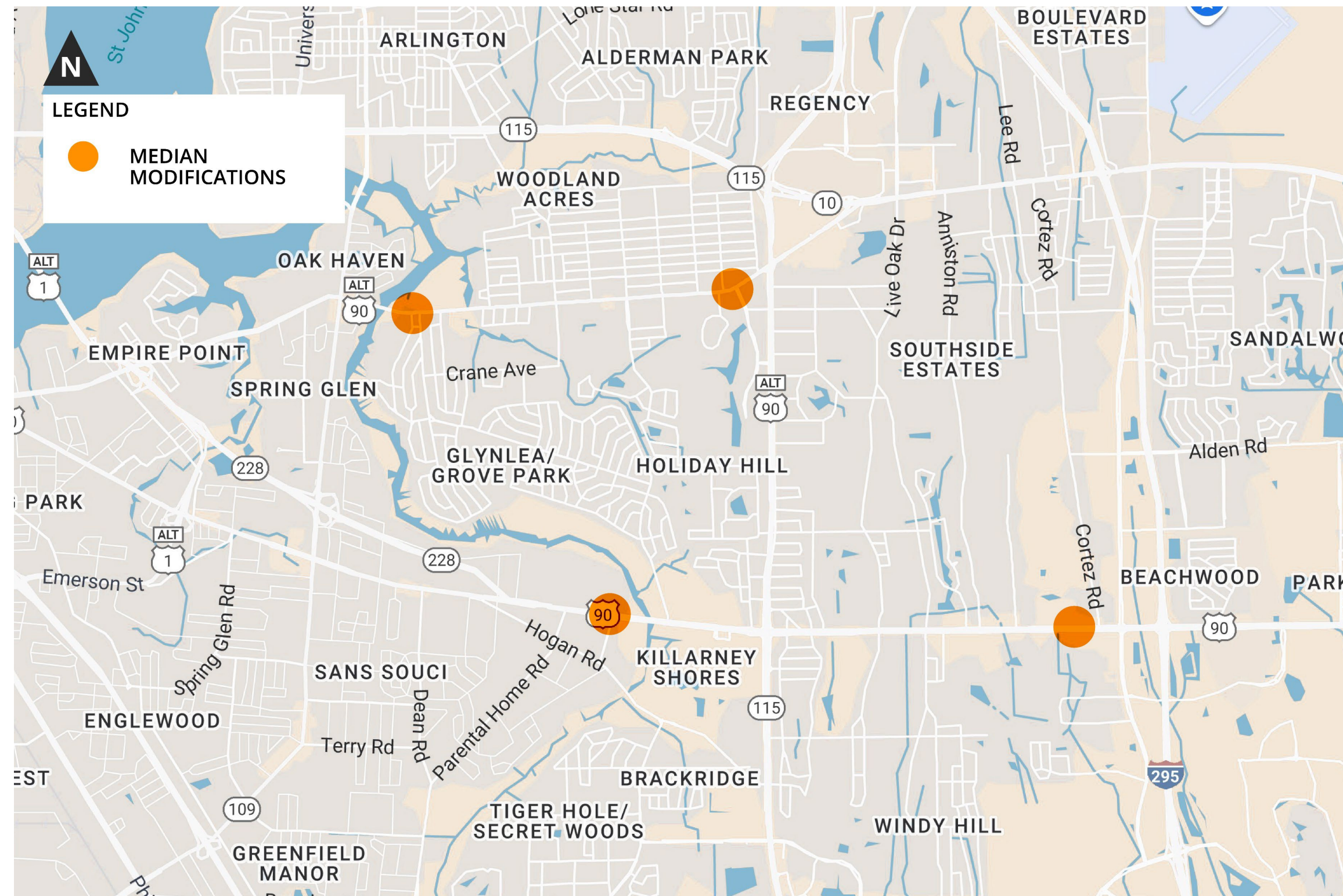

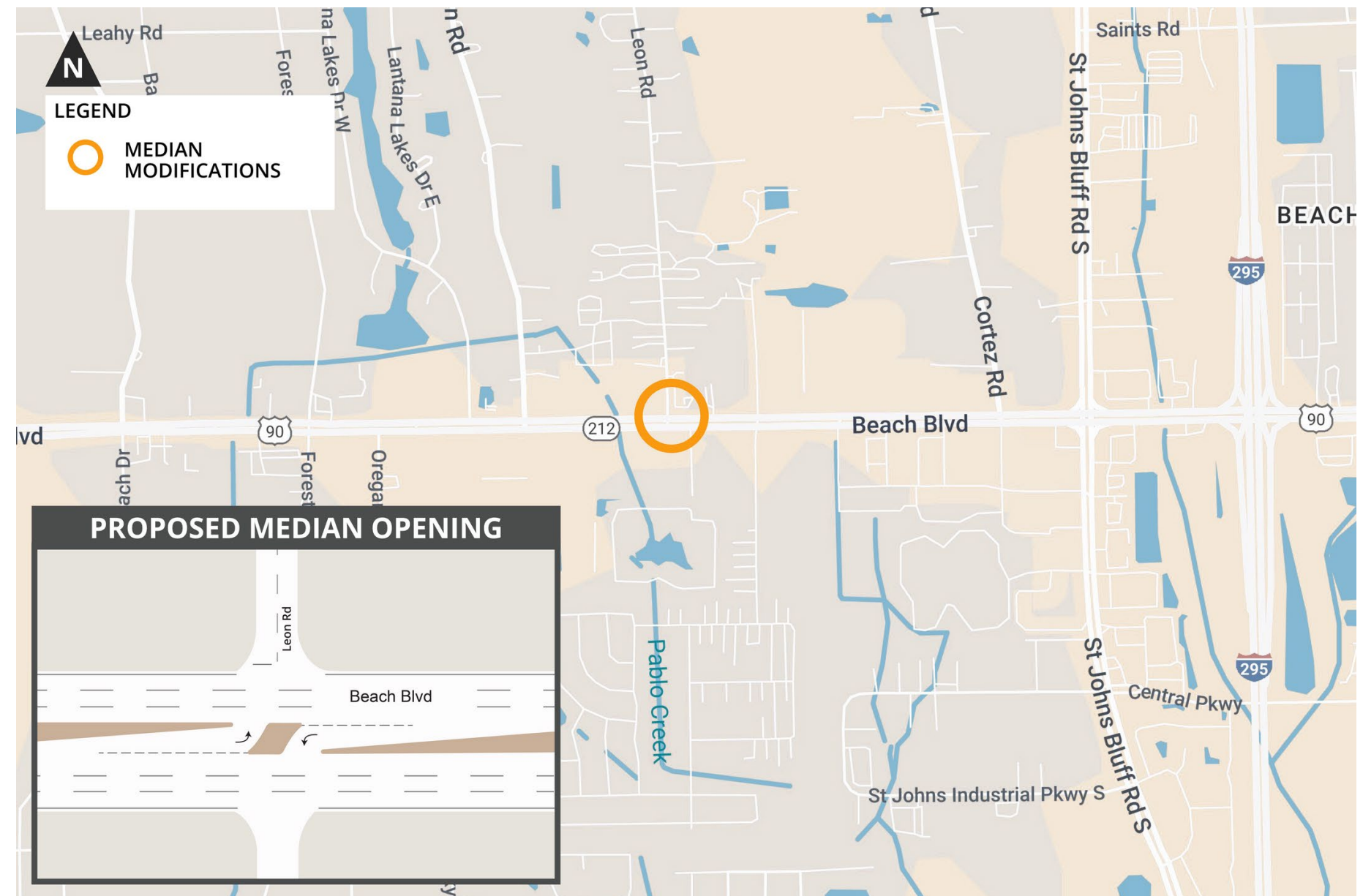

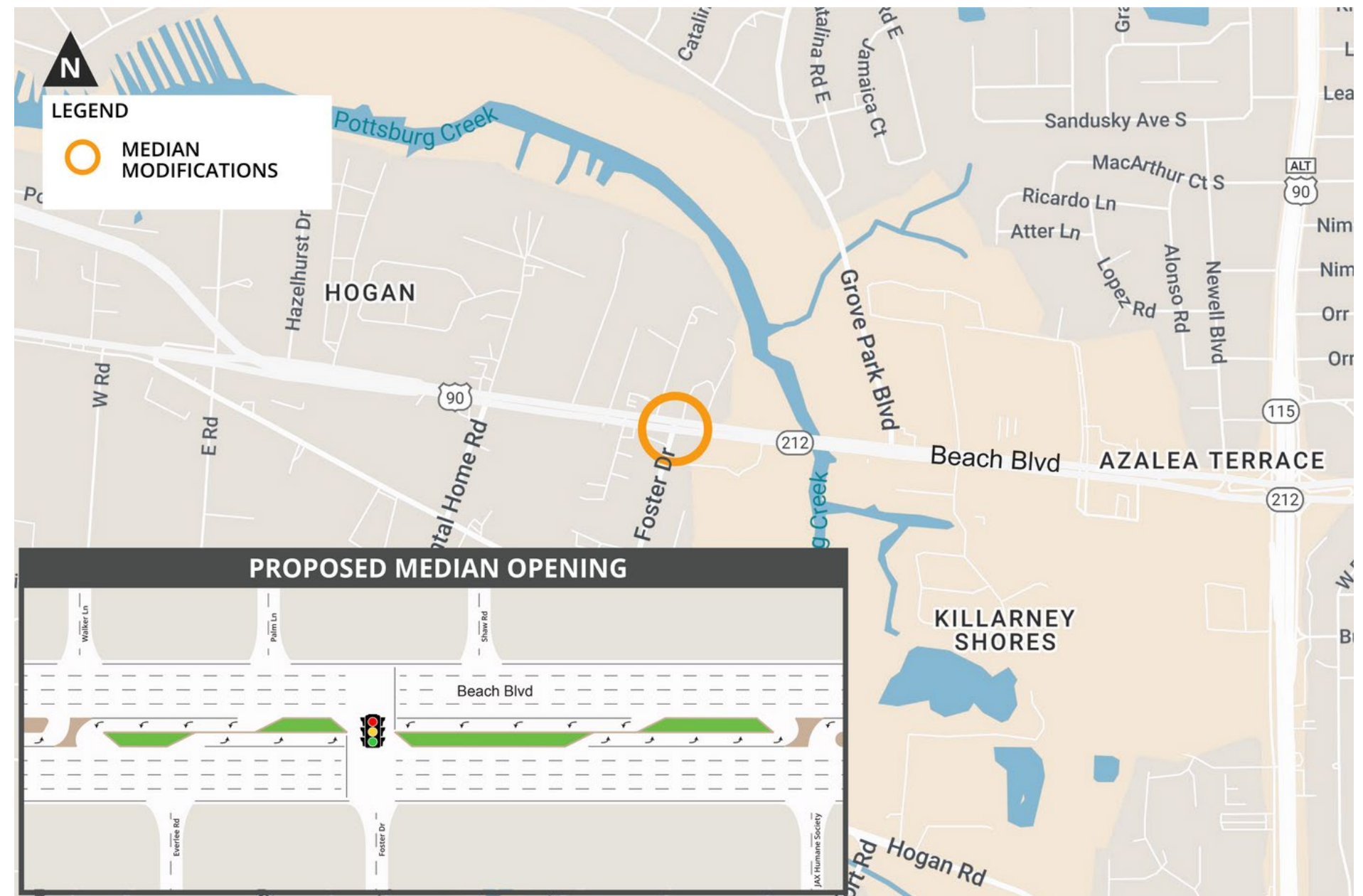
# PROPOSED MODIFICATIONS AT BEACH BOULEVARD (STATE ROAD 212) AND LEON ROAD

- Addition of a directionalized median at Leon Road to eliminate northbound and southbound left turns from Leon Road and The Salvation Army driveway.



# PROPOSED MODIFICATIONS AT BEACH BOULEVARD (STATE ROAD 212) AND FOSTER DRIVE

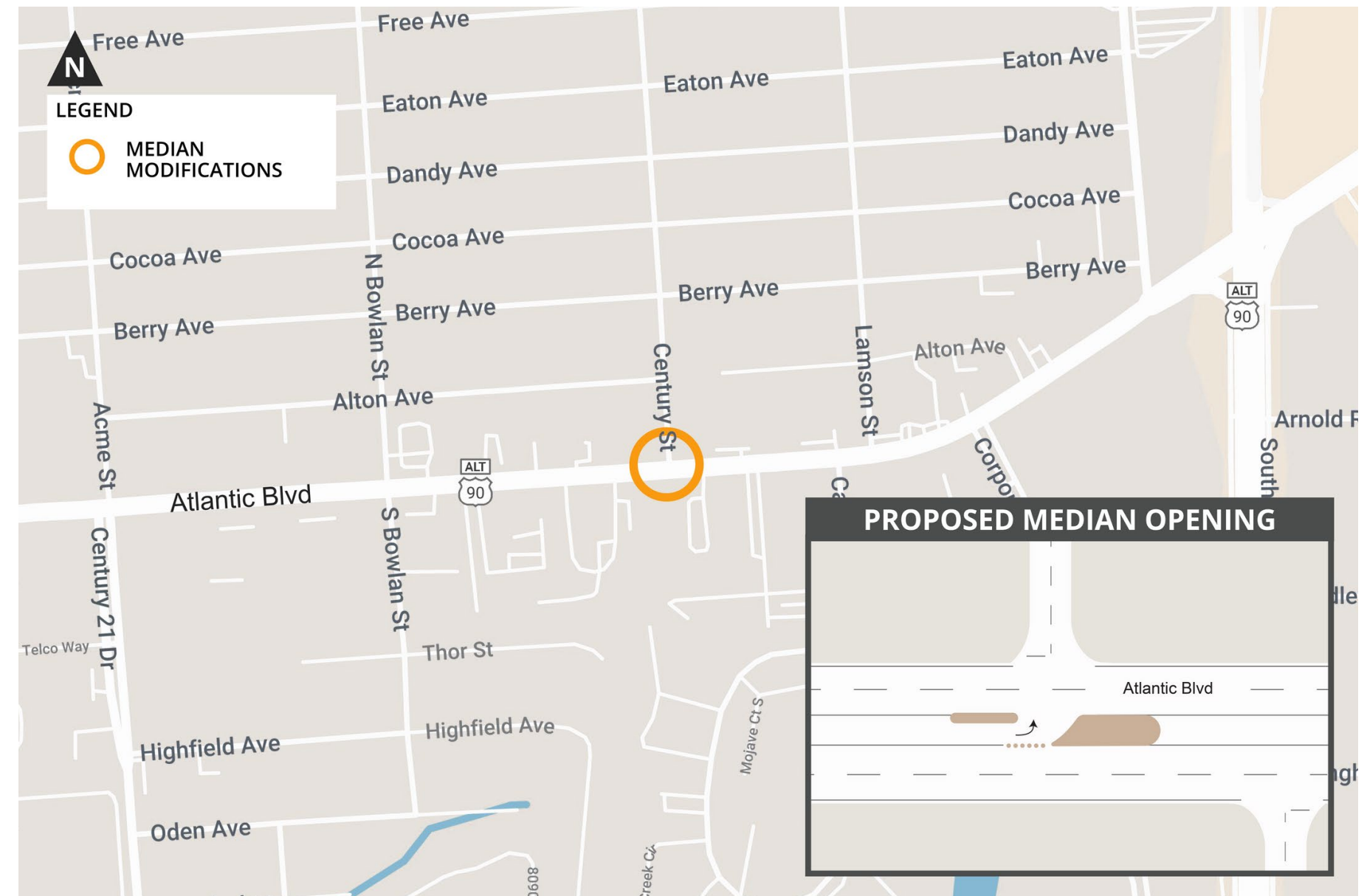
- Addition of a directionalized median at Walker Lane to eliminate northbound and southbound left turns from Walker Lane.
- Closing the median at Everlee Road to eliminate left turns into and out of Everlee Road.
- Closing the median at Palm Lane to eliminate left turns into and out of Palm Lane.
- Closing the median at Shaw Road to eliminate left turns into and out of Shaw Road.
- Addition of a directionalized median at the Jacksonville Humane Society to eliminate northbound and southbound left turns.





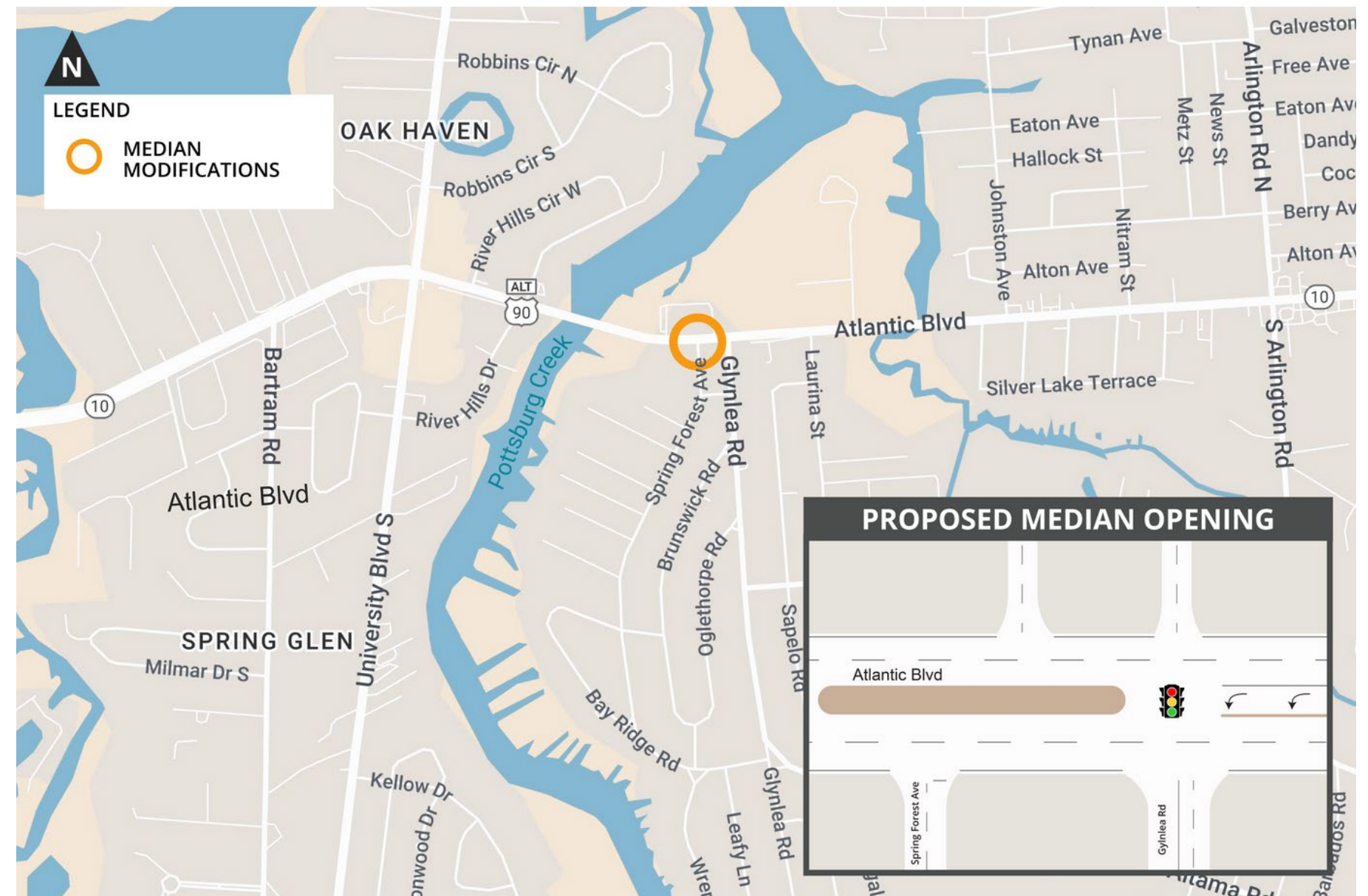
# PROPOSED MODIFICATIONS AT ATLANTIC BOULEVARD (STATE ROAD 10) AND CENTURY STREET

- Addition of a directionalized median at Century Street to eliminate southbound left turns from Century Street.

- Median modifications at Spring Forest Avenue and New Life Church to eliminate left turns.
